Encouraging Words from Pastor Chris

We celebrate all that God has done in 2025. We baptized 4 people. Through Fully Flood Florala we've knocked on over 75 doors and had multiple gospel conversations. Through Connect the Continents over 100 people made professions of faith in Uganda. You gave a record number of shoeboxes for Operation Christmas Child. We have established a Family Life Center project committee to begin to plan for our future Family Life Center. Our average attendance is on track to increase by 10 people from last year. We have hired another full-time staff member in Bro. Brad that has brought great momentum to our student ministries. Giving has officially exceeded our budgetary needs. While we certainly rejoice and praise God for these blessings, let us not be content. There is more progress to be made. 2026 is going to be a pivotal year in seeing Vision 28 become a reality and for us to be the Great Commission minded church that we need to be.

There are tremendous things coming in 2026 that I believe are going to help our church take the next step. For that to happen though, we all need to be fully invested. The time is now. Souls are at stake. Our community is riddled with the brokenness of sin. People are burdened and we have the answer in Jesus. Half-Hearted, half-focused, half-engaged involvement is not enough to minister to these burdens, specifically the burden of lostness. So, ask yourself if you are as committed to the Lord, His Word, His Church, and to the ministry of the church as much as you could be? How can you get more engaged? How can you be more faithful? What needs to happen for you to grow closer with the Lord on your end? How can you be a part of seeing a greater gospel impact in 2026?

In 2026 we are going to launch a new discipleship strategy that will promote Bible engagement, prayer, evangelism, and accountability to these disciplines. The impact that this can have on you spiritually is incalculable. You will learn how be a stronger disciple and to make disciples through engaging in one of these groups. We are going to partner with a church plant in Connecticut through NAMB. This will open doors to serve in the mission field in a variety of ways. We are going to begin a new visitor engagement ministry where we look to connect better with those who visit our church and assimilate them into our church family. We plan to begin to establish our after-school program next Fall. We will begin a Graduates and Professionals (G.A.P) ministry for our young adults. Our goal is to have a conceptual design for a Family Life Center by the end of the year. We are going to be busy about God's business, and we want to invite you to be apart of that. Let's get ready for what God is ready to do in 2026.




