Those who don't typically show up at Christmas may simply be waiting on an invitation. Most (56%) say they would likely attend church if someone they knew invited them to attend with them at Christmas time, including 17% who are very likely. Around a third (36%) say they're unlikely, including 24% who are very unlikely. Another 8% say they're not sure.

#### **Proven strategies**

- **Fill a Blank Church Provided Invitation:** Write a note and invite someone to join you for Christmas service.
- **Snap a Selfie Photo:** Send a personal photo and invite someone to join you for Christmas service (share on church Facebook/social media).
- **Record a Video:** Make a short, cheerful invite and invite someone or few friends to Christmas service (share on church Facebook/social media).
- **Send a Blessing:** Give a card, photo, or quick video to show love and invite them to Christmas service.
- **Coffee Cards:** Give members a \$5 coffee gift card, invite a friend for coffee and to Christmas service.
- Cookies: Gift a small bag of cookies and invite someone to Christmas service.
- **Gift an Ornament:** Attach the Christmas service details to a festive ornament and invite them to Christmas service.
- Write a Note: Pen a short, heartfelt invitation to Christmas service.
- Secret Santa Surprise: Leave a small gift with a personal invite them to Christmas service.
- Advent Countdown Card: Give a mini card counting down to Christmas service (mini advent calendar gifts).
- Church Puzzle Invite: Make a fun puzzle with the details of the event.
- **Church Photo Collage:** Share photos from past Christmas services with a friendly invite and invite to Christmas service.

#### **Christmas Joy Offering**

Christmas is a special time of year when we focus more fully on Jesus Christ and the joy of giving to others. A wonderful opportunity is the Christmas Joy Offering. This offering was started over 90 years ago and has evolved into all donations being split between two very worthy causes.

Half of the money raised goes to the Board of Pensions to assist those servants of the church living on inadequate pensions or needing nursing home care. The other half goes to Presbyterian racial ethnic schools and colleges. Recipients include the <u>Menaul Schools</u> in Albuquerque, NM(98% go on to college!), <u>Presbyterian Pan American School</u> in Kingsville, TX, and <u>Stillman</u> College in Tuscaloosa, AL. 
3<sup>rd</sup> graders (who are proficient in reading). You can even do it with a partner if you would like. Pastor Mark will provide training for any new worship leaders.




