Dear Pastors and Praying Friends,

Often times in my life I have found myself seeking the hand of God rather than the heart of God. All through the Bible we are commanded to seek the face of God. It's a normal desire to seek God's hand for ministry needs, but I have found out if we seek a relationship with God rather than what we can get from God He will meet those needs. Seeking God's hand can bring happiness, but seeking His heart will bring joy. Matthew 6:33 teaches us that if we seek Him and His righteousness, then all these things will be added unto us. I'm thankful how God has provided for us.

A few weeks ago, we had our annual Thanksgiving/Harvest Sunday. This is something that Baptist churches in Thailand (which are very rare) do each October. There was a great crowd with several visitors. Each person brings fruit, vegetables and rice. They place it in front of the pulpit to show God's blessing. We cook the food and have dinner on the ground.

The last week in October we were invited to take part in a missions conference at Light House Baptist Church in Tokyo, Japan. God really blessed. They committed to do even more this coming year to get the gospel around the world. They partnered with us to support the ministry. God is blessing them as they reach that city of 38 million for Christ.

We praise the Lord for His blessings on Messiah Baptist Church in Bangkok. Pastor Peter was able to use a hotel swimming pool to baptize. They also celebrated their 13th Homecoming Anniversary on October 26th, with a record number in attendance. Pray they can continue to see people saved and baptized.

We had a training day in Chiang Rai where 17 pastors and assistant pastors attended. Some of them traveled from over 3 hours away. These are great men of God that will take this knowledge back to their village churches. There may not be very many Bible believing churches in Thailand, but those that are there are serious about preaching the gospel.

We finally are able to see some progress on the new training center after the rainy season has slowed. The water well and temporary power has been installed. We are now building a wall around the property. This is something that is always done in 3rd world countries. It is an extra expense that I wasn't planning on, but it has to be done. Please pray for this great need to train young Thai and Burmese men to preach the gospel and plant churches.

Now that we have finished our deputation, our support checks will go to Central Missionary Clearinghouse (CMC.) I will still be partnering with TFFMI for the church planting part of the ministry.
