Every Christmas Eve, we gather together, to tell the same story of baby Jesus born in a manger. We tell this story because our spirits need to hear it. God has drawn close to this hurting world. This is true on Christmas Eve, and it is true at this Table We celebrate the Messiah who gathered his friends for one last supper, The Messiah who loved us so much he just couldn't stay away.

WORDS OF INSTITUTION:

In the night in which he was betrayed, our Lord Jesus took bread, gave thanks, broke it and gave it to his disciples saying, Take and eat, this is my body, given for you. Do this for the remembrance of me.

Again, after supper he took the cup, gave thanks and gave it for all to drink saying, this cup is the new covenant in my blood shed for you and for all people for the forgiveness of sin. Do this for the remembrance of me.

As we tell your story of good news, let us once again speak the prayer your Son taught us to pray, saying:

LORD'S PRAYER:

Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name, thy kingdom come, thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.
Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.

Pastor: As the light of Christ is passed from candle to candle, may his love travel through us, bringing hope and peace to the world. The journey *to* the manger becomes the journey *from* the manger—carrying the light of Christ into all places.
