Inlet Sings!


We will resume regular Wednesday rehearsals on January 14, 2026.

- 3) Donate via credit card on our website **www.inletunited.ca** using the "Give" option (select "Local Offerings/General" from the "To" drop down)
- 4) Send a cheque made out to Inlet United Church to the office. Remember to include your envelope/donor number if you have one.
