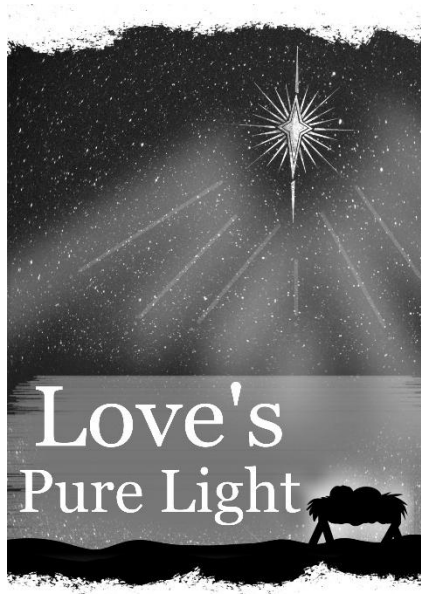
In darkness surrounded, the world waits for light,
