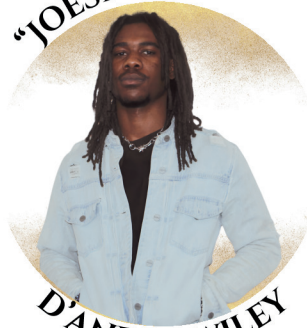
But God protects Jesus, and the truth is declared: there is only one true King – Jesus.

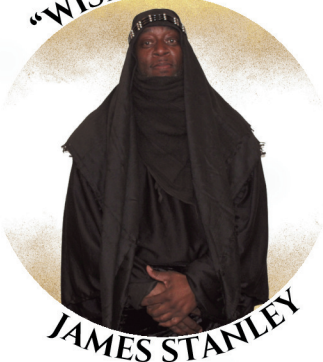

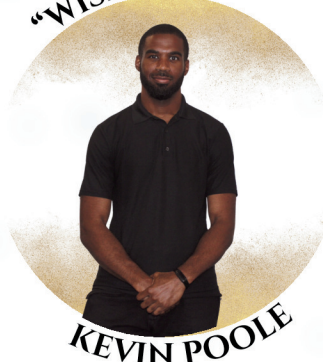
