The Trust Funds Committee will be accepting grant and scholarship applications for 2026 beginning January 15. The applications can be accessed, completed and submitted on Faith's website.

Go to www.faithlutherancedarburg.com and click on "Resources" in the menu bar. Then click on "Trust Funds and Missions of the Month," where you will find the applications for grants and scholarships. Paper grant applications will be available upon request, if necessary.

Grant applications can be submitted by any Faith member. They are generally for non-profit organizations that you would like to see us support. The amounts available are dependent on the previous year's investment earnings and the number of applications. Scholarship applications are available for any student who is pursuing post-secondary education and is a member of Faith. High school seniors and students who are already in college should complete and submit the application. The scholarships will be awarded after the fall semester of the next school year, 2026-27.

All applications will be due by February 28.

The committee will review them in March and April and awardees will be notified by the end of April.
