Did You Know? We provide financial assistance for housing and utilities once a month and food assistance twice a month to our greater community.

Through our Good Sam program, we are able to help those with rent and utility needs. This year, through your generosity and the City of Portage Grant, we have assisted over 160 people and given away over \$43,000.

Our Food Distribution and Free Store, provide fresh food, personal care, household and childcare items. Since January, we have provided food to over 6400 people. We have been able to supplement the boxes from SW Michigan Food Bank with your generous donations.
