ADVENT CANDLE LIGHTING Krissi Kahoun & Jeff Knapp

READER 1: For weeks, we have waited. We have watched. We have prayed. We have prepared our hearts for the coming of Christ. Tonight, the waiting ends. We light the Candle of Hope, remembering God's promise to come near when the world felt weary and worn. (Light the first candle.)

READER 2: We light the Candle of Peace, trusting that God brings calm and courage even in uncertain and fragile moments. (Light the second candle.)

READER 1: We light the Candle of Joy, a joy that rose from deep within, a joy strong enough to carry us through real life. (Light the third candle.)

READER 2: We light the Candle of Love, celebrating a love that made room, a love that chose nearness, a love that would not let the world go (Light the fourth candle.)

BOTH READERS: We light the Christ Candle. (Light the Christ Candle.)

ALL: *The Light has come into the world. The Word has become flesh and dwelt among us. Hope is fulfilled. Peace is born. Joy is complete. Love has come near.*

BOTH READERS: This is the light no darkness can overcome. This is the light of Christ.

ALL: *Thanks be to God. Amen.*
