

## **Order of Worship—Continued**

#### Sacrament of Holy Communion

All who seek God and a deeper life in Christ are welcome to receive Holy Communion. Please move at the direction of the ushers. You may receive the bread in open and outstretched hands and respond to receiving Communion by saying "Amen". The bread is gluten-free, and the wine is unfermented (e.g., grape-juice) If you prefer to receive a blessing instead of receiving Communion, you may indicate your choice by crossing your hands across your chest. Those who wish to have Holy Communion brought to them at their seat should notify an usher.

#### Lighting of the Christ Candle

The ushers will share the light of the Christ Candle with the person seated at the end of your row, then each person will light their own candle by holding it at an angle to their neighbor's candle, (which is held up straight), and for the final verse of Silent Night, we will raise our candles up high.
