

Showing 10 verses containing unity

Genesis 11:3-8 TLB

[3] The people who lived there began to talk about building a great city, with a temple-tower reaching to the skies-a proud, eternal monument to themselves. "This will weld us together," they said, "and keep us from scattering all over the world." So they made great piles of hard-burned brick, and collected bitumen to use as mortar. [5] But when God came down to see the city and the tower mankind was making, [6] he said, "Look! If they are able to accomplish all this when they have just begun to exploit their linguistic and political **unity**, just think of what they will do later! Nothing will be unattainable for them! [7] Come, let us go down and give them different languages, so that they won't understand each other's words!" [8] So, in that way, God scattered them all over the earth; and that ended the building of the city.

Job 10:5-11 NKJV

[5] Are Your days like the days of a mortal man? Are Your years like the days of a mighty man, [6] That You should seek for my iniquity And search out my sin, [7] Although You know that I am not wicked, And there is no one who can deliver from Your hand? [8] 'Your hands have made me and fashioned me, An intricate **unity**; Yet You would destroy me. [9] Remember, I pray, that You have made me like clay. And will You turn me into dust again? [10] Did You not pour me out like milk, And curdle me like cheese, [11] Clothe me with skin and flesh, And knit me together with bones and sinews?

Psalm 133:1-2 AMP

[1] Behold, how good and how pleasant it is For brothers to dwell together in **unity**! [2] It is like the precious oil [of consecration] poured on the head, Coming down on the beard, Even the beard of Aaron, Coming down upon the edge of his [priestly] robes [consecrating the whole body].

Zechariah 11:12-16 TLB

[12] And I said to their leaders, "If you like, give me my pay, whatever I am worth; but only if you want to." So they counted out thirty little silver coins as my wages. [13] And the Lord told me, "Use it to buy a field from the pottery makers-this magnificent sum they value you at!" So I took the thirty coins and threw them into the Temple for the pottery makers. [14] Then I broke my other staff, "Union," to show that the bond of **unity** between Judah and Israel was broken. [15] Then the Lord told me to go again and get a job as a shepherd; this time I was to act the part of a worthless, wicked shepherd. [16] And he said to me, "This illustrates how I will give this nation a shepherd who will not care for the dying ones, nor look after the young, nor heal the

broken bones, nor feed the healthy ones, nor carry the lame that cannot walk; instead, he will eat the fat ones, even tearing off their feet.

John 17:21-24 TLB

[21] My prayer for all of them is that they will be of one heart and mind, just as you and I are, Father—that just as you are in me and I am in you, so they will be in us, and the world will believe you sent me. [22] "I have given them the glory you gave me—the glorious **unity** of being one, as we are— [23] I in them and you in me, all being perfected into one—so that the world will know you sent me and will understand that you love them as much as you love me. [24] Father, I want them with me—these you've given me—so that they can see my glory. You gave me the glory because you loved me before the world began!

John 17:21-25 LSB

[21] that they may all be one; even as You, Father, are in Me and I in You, that they also may be in Us, so that the world may believe that You sent Me. [22] The glory which You have given Me I have given to them, that they may be one, just as We are one; [23] I in them and You in Me, that they may be perfected in **unity**, so that the world may know that You sent Me, and loved them, even as You have loved Me. [24] Father, I desire that they also, whom You have given Me, be with Me where I am, so that they may see My glory which You have given Me, for You loved Me before the foundation of the world. [25] "O righteous Father, although the world has not known You, yet I have known You; and these have known that You sent Me;

Ephesians 2:12-15 AMP

[12] remember that at that time you were separated from Christ [excluded from any relationship with Him], alienated from the commonwealth of Israel, and strangers to the covenants of promise [with no share in the sacred Messianic promise and without knowledge of God's agreements], having no hope [in His promise] and [living] in the world without God. [13] But now [at this very moment] in Christ Jesus you who once were [so very] far away [from God] have been brought near by the blood of Christ. [14] For He Himself is our peace and our bond of **unity**. He who made both groups—[Jews and Gentiles]—into one body and broke down the barrier, the dividing wall [of spiritual antagonism between us], [15] by abolishing in His [own crucified] flesh the hostility caused by the Law with its commandments contained in ordinances [which He satisfied]; so that in Himself He might make the two into one new man, thereby establishing peace.

Ephesians 4:1-6 HCSB

[1] Therefore I, the prisoner for the Lord, urge you to walk worthy of the calling you have received, [2] with all humility and gentleness, with patience, accepting one

another in love, [3] diligently keeping the **unity** of the Spirit with the peace that binds us. [4] There is one body and one Spirit-just as you were called to one hope at your calling- [5] one Lord, one faith, one baptism, [6] one God and Father of all, who is above all and through all and in all.

Ephesians 4:11-14 AMP

[11] And [His gifts to the church were varied and] He Himself appointed some as apostles [special messengers, representatives], some as prophets [who speak a new message from God to the people], some as evangelists [who spread the good news of salvation], and some as pastors and teachers [to shepherd and guide and instruct], [12] [and He did this] to fully equip and perfect the saints (God's people) for works of service, to build up the body of Christ [the church]; [13] until we all reach oneness in the faith and in the knowledge of the Son of God, [growing spiritually] to become a mature believer, reaching to the measure of the fullness of Christ [manifesting His spiritual completeness and exercising our spiritual gifts in **unity**]. [14] So that we are no longer children [spiritually immature], tossed back and forth [like ships on a stormy sea] and carried about by every wind of [shifting] doctrine, by the cunning and trickery of [unscrupulous] men, by the deceitful scheming of people ready to do anything [for personal profit].

Colossians 3:12-15 AMP

[12] So, as God's own chosen people, who are holy [set apart, sanctified for His purpose] and well-beloved [by God Himself], put on a heart of compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience [which has the power to endure whatever injustice or unpleasantness comes, with good temper]; [13] bearing graciously with one another, and willingly forgiving each other if one has a cause for complaint against another; just as the Lord has forgiven you, so should you forgive. [14] Beyond all these things put on and wrap yourselves in [unselfish] love, which is the perfect bond of **unity** [for everything is bound together in agreement when each one seeks the best for others]. [15] Let the peace of Christ [the inner calm of one who walks daily with Him] be the controlling factor in your hearts [deciding and settling questions that arise]. To this peace indeed you were called as members in one body [of believers]. And be thankful [to God always].
