Matthew 6:5-10 LSB

[5] "And when you pray, you are not to be like **the** hypocrites; for **they** love to stand and pray in **the** synagogues and on **the** street corners so that **they** may be seen by men. Truly I say to you, **they** have **their** reward in full. [6] But you, when you pray, go into your inner room, and when you have shut your door, pray to your Father who is in secret, and your Father who sees what is done in secret will reward you. [7] "And when you are **praying**, do not use meaningless repetition as **the** Gentiles do, for **they** suppose that **they** will be heard for **their** many **words**. [8] **Therefore**, do not be like **them**; for your Father knows what you need before you ask Him. [9] "Pray, **then**, in this way: 'Our Father who is in heaven, Hallowed be Your name. [10] 'Your kingdom come. Your will be done, On earth as it is in heaven.

Romans 8:24-28 TLB

[24] We are saved by trusting. And trusting means looking forward to getting something we don't yet have-for a man who already has something doesn't need to hope and trust that he will get it. [25] But if we must keep trusting God for something that hasn't happened yet, it teaches us to wait patiently and confidently. [26] And in **the** same way-by our faith-**the** Holy Spirit helps us with our daily problems and in our **praying**. For we don't even know what we should pray for nor how to pray as we should, but **the** Holy Spirit prays for us with such feeling that it cannot be expressed in **words**. [27] And **the** Father who knows all hearts knows, of course, what **the** Spirit is saying as he pleads for us in harmony with God's own will. [28] And we know that all that happens to us is working for our good if we love God and are fitting into his plans.

Colossians 4:1-6 LSB

[1] Masters, show to your slaves what is right and fair, knowing that you too have a Master in heaven. [2] Devote yourselves to prayer, being watchful in it with thanksgiving; [3] **praying** at **the** same time for us as well, that God will open up to us a door for **the word**, so that we may speak **the** mystery of Christ, for which I have also been bound, [4] that I may make it manifest in **the** way I ought to speak. [5] Walk in wisdom toward outsiders, redeeming **the** time. [6] Let your **words** always be with grace, seasoned with salt, so that you will know how you should answer each person.
