Interested party #1 (the Messianic Synagogue) has had someone looking at the property three times. The last time, a whole group of 10 adults were there. They have not given us an answer. (Brazilian culture dictates that it is unkind to say no. So, they don't say anything.) Interested party #2 appeared. It is a Christian day school, interested in putting a branch in our neighborhood. A couple looked. Their offer was very low and they did not pursue. We need wisdom. We also need a serious buyer! With money.

This is not a **great time politically or economically** in Brazil, and we try to take that in consideration. But, we know that the Lord does not depend on the political or economical climate. When it is His Time, it will be sold. The hard part is waiting.

One of our daughters and family will be joining us for Thanksgiving. So, we are thankful that 25% of the family can be here with us! Even a little time with part of the family is precious. We enjoyed seeing 3 of the girls and their families in late September.

Robert continues working on his book, ***Silhouettes of Messiah in the Old Testament*** and it is coming along. Although he wrote his *Messianic Family Haggadah* (Passover Ceremonial book) years ago, this is a completely different kind of book, and there has been a learning curve, from WordPerfect to Microsoft Word (*with Hebrew!*). The better shape the manuscript is in when he hands it to his Sister-the-Editor, the easier it will be for her. And meanwhile, she has given orientation and guidelines as to how he should proceed, turning messages plus research into readable text. Rachel Overton is indeed a professional editor and it is a big help to have her not only in the family, but geographically located 3 1/2 miles away! We bribe her with homemade bread and other treats from time to time.

Jane has been teaching the Ladies ABF (Adult Bible Fellowship) class for ladies at Huntsburg this quarter. The theme is Contentment, based on a book by Juanita Purcell, an RBP publication. I think the Lord knew she would need these reminders as much as the ladies with whom she is sharing.

Jane is the peeler. Robert is the masher and handler of heavy pots. (We also work together on homemade bread, when we make it. Jane puts it together. Robert kneads it, as Jane is no longer able to do that. And he does a better job than she ever did!!).

This past Saturday, the men from the ***Vida & Paz*** (Life and Peace) Baptist Church attended the annual Men's Retreat in Rio de Janeiro. There were over 60 men represented from five churches. We received a lot of pictures and comments!
