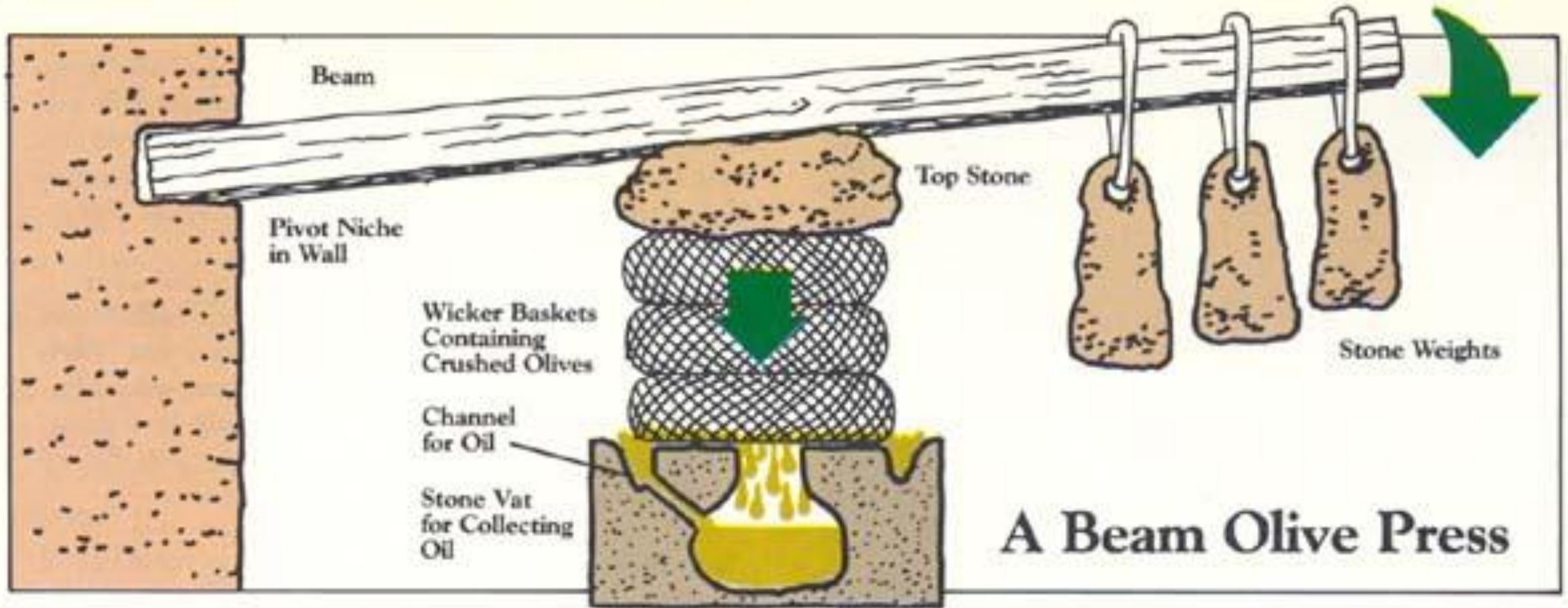

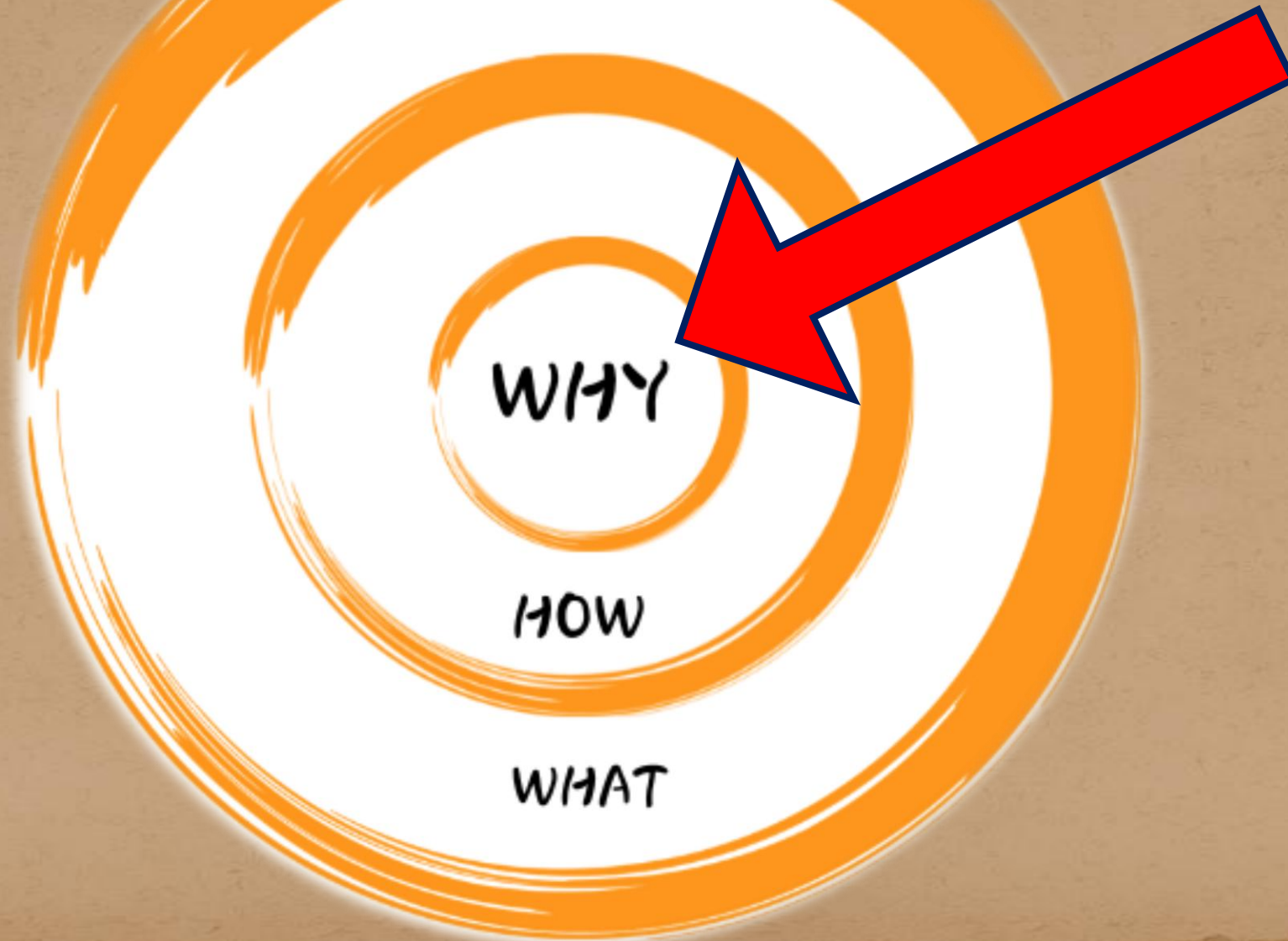

2 Timothy 2

1 So then, since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses, let us, too, put aside every impediment — that is, the sin which easily hampers our forward movement — and keep running with endurance in the contest set before us, 2 **looking away to the Initiator and Completer of that trusting, Yeshua — WHO, IN EXCHANGE FOR OBTAINING THE JOY SET BEFORE HIM, ENDURED** execution on a stake as a criminal, scorning the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.

THE WHY

Isaiah 53



¹Who believes our report? To whom is the arm of Adonai revealed? ²For before him he grew up like a young plant, like a root out of dry ground. He was not well-formed or especially handsome; we saw him, but his appearance did not attract us. ³People despised and avoided him, a man of pains, well acquainted with illness.

Isaiah 53



Like someone from whom people turn their faces, he was despised; we did not value him. 4 In fact, it was our diseases he bore, our pains from which he suffered; yet we regarded him as punished, stricken and afflicted by God. 5 **But he was**

WOUNDED because of our crimes, **CRUSHED** because of our sins; the **DISCIPLINING** that **MAKES US WHOLE** fell on him, and by his **BRUISES** **WE ARE HEALED**

THE WHY

Isaiah 53



6 We all, like sheep, went astray; we turned, each one, to his own way; yet Adonai laid on him the guilt of all of us. 7 Though mistreated, **he was submissive — he did not open his mouth**. Like a lamb led to be slaughtered, like a sheep silent before its shearers, **he did not open his mouth**.

Isaiah 53



After forcible arrest and sentencing, he was taken away; and none of his generation protested his being cut off from the land of the living for the crimes of my people, who deserved the punishment themselves. He was given a grave among the wicked; in his death he was with a rich man. Although he had done no violence and had said nothing deceptive, 10 yet it pleased Adonai **TO CRUSH** **HIM** with illness, to see if he would present himself as a guilt offering.

If he does, he will see his offspring; and he will prolong his days;
and **AT HIS HAND ADONAI'S DESIRE WILL BE**
ACCOMPLISHED.

Isaiah 53



11 After this ordeal, he will see satisfaction. “By his knowing [pain and sacrifice], my righteous servant **MAKES MANY** **RIGHTEOUS**; it is for their sins that he suffers. 12 Therefore I will assign him a share with the great, he will divide the spoil with the mighty, for having exposed himself to death and being counted among the sinners while actually bearing the sin of many and interceding for the offenders.”

THE WHY

Acts 1



8 But **you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; AND YOU WILL BE MY WITNESSES** in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.” 9 After he said this, he was taken up before their very eyes, and a cloud hid him from their sight.

2 Peter 3



9 The Lord is not slow in keeping his promise, as some people think of slowness; on the contrary, he is patient with you; for **it is not his purpose that anyone should be destroyed, but that everyone should turn from his sins.**

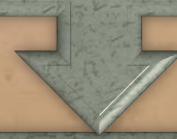
