In the night in which he was betrayed, our Lord Jesus took bread, and gave thanks; broke it, and gave it to his disciples, saying: 'Take and eat; this is my body, given for you. Do this for the remembrance of me.' Again, after supper, he took the cup, gave thanks, and gave it for all to drink, saying: 'This cup is the new covenant in my blood, shed for you and for all people for the forgiveness of sin. Do this for the remembrance of me. Remembering these your mighty acts in Jesus Christ, let us proclaim the mystery of faith.

**C: Christ has died, Christ is risen, Christ will come again.**

P: Pour out your Holy Spirit on us gathered here and on these gifts of bread and juice, make them be for us the body and blood of Christ, so that we may be the body of Christ, redeemed by his blood. We pray all this through the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. **Amen**
