**1 Timothy 1:18-19**, “*This command I entrust to you, Timothy, my son, that you fight the good fight, keep the faith, and a good conscience, which some have rejected and suffered shipwreck in regard to their faith.*”

**1 Timothy 2:1-2**, “*First of all, I urge that entreaties and prayers, petitions and thanksgivings, be made on behalf of all men, <sup>2</sup>for kings and all who are in authority, so that we may lead a tranquil and quiet life in all godliness and dignity.*”

#### 1. First of All, Pray on Behalf of All People

**Psalm 5:3**, “*In the morning, O Lord, You will hear my voice; in the morning I will order my prayer to You and eagerly watch.*”

**Psalm 59:16**, “*But as for me, I shall sing of Your strength; yes, I shall joyfully sing of Your lovingkindness in the morning.*”

**Psalm 88:13**, “*In the morning my prayer comes before You.*”

**Psalm 143:8**, “*Let me hear Your lovingkindness in the morning; for I trust in You; teach me the way in which I should walk; for to You I lift up my soul.*”

**1 Timothy 4:6**, “*Be constantly nourished on the words of the faith.*”

#### 2. Be Constantly Nourished on the Words of the Faith

**1 Peter 2:2**, “*Like newborn babies, long for the pure milk of the word, so that by it you may grow in respect to salvation.*”

**Matthew 4:4**, “*Man shall not live on bread alone, but on every word that proceeds out of the mouth of God.*”

**Jeremiah 15:16**, “*Your words were found and I ate them, and Your words became for me a joy and the delight of my heart.*”

**1 Timothy 4:7-9**, “*Discipline yourself for the purpose of godliness; <sup>8</sup>for bodily discipline is only of little profit, but godliness is profitable for all things, since it holds promise for the present life and also for the life to come. <sup>9</sup>It is a trustworthy statement deserving full acceptance.*”

### **3. Discipline Yourself for the Purpose of Godliness**

**Discipline:** to train and to exercise

**Godliness:** devout reverence in attitude and conduct, especially devotion to the gospel plan.

**1 Timothy 6:11-12**, “*Pursue righteousness, godliness, faith, love, perseverance and gentleness. <sup>12</sup>Fight the good fight of faith; take hold of the eternal life to which you were called, and you made the good confession in the presence of many witnesses.*”
