Matthew 4:6 AMP

And he said [mockingly] to Him, "If You are the Son of God, throw Yourself down; for it is written, 'HE WILL COMMAND HIS ANGELS CONCERNING YOU [to **serve**, care for, protect and watch over You]'; and 'THEY WILL LIFT YOU UP ON their HANDS, SO THAT YOU WILL NOT STRIKE YOUR FOOT AGAINST A STONE.'"

Matthew 4:10 AMP

Then Jesus said to him, "Go away, Satan! For it is written and forever remains written, 'YOU SHALL WORSHIP THE LORD YOUR GOD, AND **SERVE** HIM ONLY.'"

Matthew 4:11 HCSB

Then the Devil left Him, and immediately angels came and began to **serve** Him.

Matthew 6:24 AMP

"No one can **serve** two masters; for either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will be devoted to the one and despise the other. You cannot **serve** God and mammon [money, possessions, fame, status, or whatever is valued more than the Lord].

Matthew 8:15 AMP

He touched her hand and the fever left her; and she got up and **served** Him.

Matthew 20:27 TLB

And if you want to be right at the top, you must **serve** like a slave.

Matthew 20:28 AMP

just as the Son of Man did not come to be **served**, but to **serve**, and to give His life as a ransom for many [paying the price to set them free from the penalty of sin]."

Matthew 26:23 TLB

He replied, "It is the one I **served** first.

Mark 1:13 HCSB

He was in the wilderness 40 days, being tempted by Satan. He was with the wild animals, and the angels began to **serve** Him.

Mark 1:31 AMP

Jesus went to her, and taking her by the hand, raised her up; and the fever left her, and she began to **serve** them [as her guests].

Mark 8:6 AMP

He directed the people to sit down on the ground; and taking the seven loaves, He gave thanks and broke them, and [repeatedly] gave them to His disciples to set before them, and they **served** the crowd.

Mark 8:7 HCSB

They also had a few small fish, and when He had blessed them, He said these were to be **served** as well.

Mark 10:45 AMP

For even the Son of Man did not come to be **served**, but to **serve**, and to give His life as a ransom for many."

Luke 1:16 AMP

He will turn many of the sons of Israel back [from sin] to [love and **serve**] the Lord their God.

Luke 1:74 AMP

To grant us that we, being rescued from the hand of our enemies, Might **serve** Him without fear,

Luke 1:75 YLT

To **serve** Him, in holiness and righteousness Before Him, all the days of our life.

Luke 2:37 KJVS

And she was a widow of about fourscore and four years, which departed not from the temple, but **served** God with fastings and prayers night and day.

Luke 4:8 AMP

Jesus replied to him, "It is written and forever remains written, 'YOU SHALL WORSHIP THE LORD YOUR GOD AND **SERVE** ONLY HIM.'"

Luke 4:39 HCSB

So He stood over her and rebuked the fever, and it left her. She got up immediately and began to **serve** them.

Luke 10:40 HCSB

But Martha was distracted by her many tasks, and she came up and asked, "Lord, don't You care that my sister has left me to **serve** alone? So tell her to give me a hand."

Luke 11:6 AMP

for a friend of mine who is on a journey has just come to visit me, and I have nothing to **serve** him';

Luke 12:37 AMP

Blessed (happy, prosperous, to be admired) are those servants whom the master finds awake and watching when he arrives. I assure you and most solemnly say to you, he will prepare himself to **serve**, and will have them recline at the table, and will come and wait on them.

Luke 15:29 AMP

But he said to his father, 'Look! These many years I have **served** you, and I have never neglected or disobeyed your command. Yet you have never given me [so much as] a young goat, so that I might celebrate with my friends;

Luke 16:13 AMP

No servant can **serve** two masters; for either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will stand devotedly by the one and despise the other. You cannot **serve** both God and mammon [that is, your earthly possessions or anything else you trust in and rely on instead of God]."

Luke 17:7 TLB

When a servant comes in from plowing or taking care of sheep, he doesn't just sit down and eat, but first prepares his master's meal and **serves** him his supper before he eats his own. And he is not even thanked, for he is merely doing what he is supposed to do.

Luke 17:8 AMP

Will he not instead say to him, 'Prepare something for me to eat, and appropriately clothe yourself [for service] and **serve** me while I eat and drink; then afterward you may eat and drink?'

Luke 22:26 KJVS

But ye shall not be so: but he that is greatest among you, let him be as the younger; and he that is chief, as he that doth **serve**.

Luke 22:27 AMP

For who is the greater, the one who reclines at the table or the one who **serves**? Is it not the one who reclines at the table? But I am among you as the one who **serves**.

John 2:10 AMP

and said to him, "Everyone else **serves** his best wine first, and when people have

drunk freely, then he **serves** that which is not so good; but you have kept back the good wine until now.”

John 10:12 AMP

But the hired man [who merely **serves** for wages], who is neither the shepherd nor the owner of the sheep, when he sees the wolf coming, deserts the flock and runs away; and the wolf snatches the sheep and scatters them.

John 10:13 AMP

The man runs because he is a hired hand [who **serves** only for wages] and is not concerned about the [safety of the] sheep.

John 12:2 KJVS

There they made him a supper; and Martha **served**: but Lazarus was one of them that sat at the table with him.

John 12:26 AMP

If anyone **serves** Me, he must [continue to faithfully] follow Me [without hesitation, holding steadfastly to Me, conforming to My example in living and, if need be, suffering or perhaps dying because of faith in Me]; and wherever I am [in heaven's glory], there will My servant be also. If anyone **serves** Me, the Father will honor him.

Acts 4:28 AMP

to do whatever Your hand and Your purpose predestined [before the creation of the world] to occur [and so without knowing it, they **served** Your own purpose].

Acts 6:2 AMP

So the Twelve called the disciples together and said, “It is not appropriate for us to neglect [teaching] the word of God in order to **serve** tables and manage the distribution of food.

Acts 7:6 YLT

‘And God spake thus, That his seed shall be sojourning in a strange land, and they shall cause it to **serve**, and shall do it evil four hundred years,

Acts 7:7 AMP

‘AND I WILL JUDGE ANY NATION TO WHOM THEY WILL BE IN BONDAGE,’ said God, ‘AND AFTER THAT THEY WILL COME OUT AND **SERVE** ME [in worship] IN THIS PLACE.’

Acts 7:42 AMP

But God turned away [from them] and handed them over to **serve** the host of heaven. As it is written and forever remains written in the book of the prophets, ‘IT WAS NOT

[really] TO ME THAT YOU OFFERED VICTIMS AND SACRIFICES FOR FORTY YEARS IN THE WILDERNESS, WAS IT, O HOUSE OF ISRAEL?

Acts 13:36 AMP

For David, after he had **served** the purpose of God in his own generation, fell asleep and was buried among his fathers and experienced decay [in the grave];

Acts 17:25 AMP

nor is He **served** by human hands, as though He needed anything, because it is He who gives to all [people] life and breath and all things.

Acts 24:14 AMP

But I confess this to you, that according to the Way, which they call a [divisive and heretical] sect, I do worship and **serve** the God of our fathers, [confidently] believing everything that is in accordance with the Law [of Moses] and that is written in the Prophets;

Acts 26:7 AMP

Which hope [of the Messiah and the resurrection] our twelve tribes [confidently] expect to realize as they **serve** and worship God in earnest night and day. And for this hope, O King, I am being accused by Jews!

Acts 26:16 AMP

Get up and stand on your feet. I have appeared to you for this purpose, to appoint you [to **serve**] as a minister and as a witness [to testify, with authority,] not only to the things which you have seen, but also to the things in which I will appear to you,

Acts 27:23 AMP

For this very night an angel of the God to whom I belong and whom I **serve** stood before me,

Romans 1:9 AMP

For God, whom I **serve** with my spirit by preaching the gospel of His Son, is my witness as to how continuously I mention you

Romans 1:25 AMP

because [by choice] they exchanged the truth of God for a lie, and worshiped and **served** the creature rather than the Creator, who is blessed forever! Amen.

Romans 3:5 TLB

"But," some say, "our breaking faith with God is good, our sins **serve** a good purpose, for people will notice how good God is when they see how bad we are. Is it fair, then,

for him to punish us when our sins are helping him?" (That is the way some people talk.)

Romans 3:20 TLB

Now do you see it? No one can ever be made right in God's sight by doing what the law commands. For the more we know of God's laws, the clearer it becomes that we aren't obeying them; his laws **serve** only to make us see that we are sinners.

Romans 6:6 KJVS

Knowing this, that our old man is crucified with him, that the body of sin might be destroyed, that henceforth we should not **serve** sin.

Romans 7:6 AMP

But now we have been released from the Law and its penalty, having died [through Christ] to that by which we were held captive, so that we **serve** [God] in the newness of the Spirit and not in the oldness of the letter [of the Law].

Romans 7:25 AMP

Thanks be to God [for my deliverance] through Jesus Christ our Lord! So then, on the one hand I myself with my mind **serve** the law of God, but on the other, with my flesh [my human nature, my worldliness, my sinful capacity—I **serve**] the law of sin.

Romans 9:12 AMP

it was said to her, "THE OLDER (Esau) WILL **SERVE** THE YOUNGER (Jacob)."

Romans 12:7 TLB

If your gift is that of serving others, **serve** them well. If you are a teacher, do a good job of teaching.

Romans 12:11 HCSB

Do not lack diligence; be fervent in spirit; **serve** the Lord.

Romans 14:4 AMP

Who are you to judge the servant of another? Before his own master he stands [approved] or falls [out of favor]. And he [who **serves** the Master—the Lord] will stand, for the Lord is able to make him stand.

Romans 14:18 AMP

For the one who **serves** Christ in this way [recognizing that food choice is secondary] is acceptable to God and is approved by men.

Romans 15:25 AMP

But for now, I am going to Jerusalem to **serve** the saints (Jewish believers).

Romans 15:27 AMP

They were pleased to do it, and they are indebted to them. For if the Gentiles have come to share in their spiritual things, then they are indebted to **serve** them also in [tangible] material things.

Romans 16:18 AMP

For such people do not **serve** our Lord Christ, but their own appetites and base desires. By smooth and flattering speech they deceive the hearts of the unsuspecting [the innocent and the naive].

1 Corinthians 7:35 NKJV

And this I say for your own profit, not that I may put a leash on you, but for what is proper, and that you may **serve** the Lord without distraction.

1 Corinthians 9:7 AMP

[Consider this:] Who at any time **serves** as a soldier at his own expense? Who plants a vineyard and does not eat its fruit? Or who tends a flock and does not use the milk of the flock?

1 Corinthians 9:13 HCSB

Don't you know that those who perform the temple services eat the food from the temple, and those who **serve** at the altar share in the offerings of the altar?

1 Corinthians 10:27 AMP

If one of the unbelievers invites you [to a meal at his home] and you want to go, eat whatever is **served** to you without asking questions [about its source] for the sake of your conscience.

1 Corinthians 12:5 AMP

And there are [distinctive] varieties of ministries and service, but it is the same Lord [who is **served**].

1 Corinthians 14:22 KJVS

Wherefore tongues are for a sign, not to them that believe, but to them that believe not: but prophesying **serveth** not for them that believe not, but for them which believe.

2 Corinthians 4:11 TLB

Yes, we live under constant danger to our lives because we **serve** the Lord, but this

gives us constant opportunities to show forth the power of Jesus Christ within our dying bodies.

2 Corinthians 11:8 TLB

Instead I "robbed" other churches by taking what they sent me and using it up while I was with you so that I could **serve** you without cost. And when that was gone and I was getting hungry, I still didn't ask you for anything, for the Christians from Macedonia brought me another gift. I have never yet asked you for one cent, and I never will.

2 Corinthians 11:23 TLB

They say they **serve** Christ? But I have **served** him far more! (Have I gone mad to boast like this?) I have worked harder, been put in jail more often, been whipped times without number, and faced death again and again and again.

Galatians 3:19 KJVS

Wherefore then **serveth** the law? It was added because of transgressions, till the seed should come to whom the promise was made; and it was ordained by angels in the hand of a mediator.

Galatians 4:8 NKJV

But then, indeed, when you did not know God, you **served** those which by nature are not gods.

Galatians 5:13 AMP

For you, my brothers, were called to freedom; only do not let your freedom become an opportunity for the sinful nature (worldliness, selfishness), but through love **serve** and seek the best for one another.

Ephesians 6:5 TLB

Slaves, obey your masters; be eager to give them your very best. **Serve** them as you would Christ.

Ephesians 6:7 HCSB

Serve with a good attitude, as to the Lord and not to men,

Philippians 1:12 AMP

Now I want you to know, believers, that what has happened to me [this imprisonment that was meant to stop me] has actually **served** to advance [the spread of] the good news [regarding salvation].

Philippians 2:22 AMP

But you know of Timothy's tested worth and his proven character, that he has **served** with me to advance the gospel like a son serving with his father.

Philippians 3:3 HCSB

For we are the circumcision, the ones who **serve** by the Spirit of God, boast in Christ Jesus, and do not put confidence in the flesh-

Colossians 3:24 AMP

knowing [with all certainty] that it is from the Lord [not from men] that you will receive the inheritance which is your [greatest] reward. It is the Lord Christ whom you [actually] **serve**.

Colossians 4:7 TLB

Tychicus, our much-loved brother, will tell you how I am getting along. He is a hard worker and **serves** the Lord with me.

1 Thessalonians 1:9 AMP

For they themselves report about us, telling what kind of reception we had among you, and how you turned to God from idols to **serve** the living and true God,

1 Thessalonians 2:4 TLB

For we speak as messengers from God, trusted by him to tell the truth; we change his message not one bit to suit the taste of those who hear it; for we **serve** God alone, who examines our hearts' deepest thoughts.

1 Timothy 3:10 AMP

These men must first be tested; then if they are found to be blameless and beyond reproach [in their Christian lives], let them **serve** as deacons.

1 Timothy 3:13 AMP

For those who have **served** well as deacons gain a high standing [having a good reputation among the congregation], and great confidence in the faith which is [founded on and centered] in Christ Jesus.

1 Timothy 3:16 TLB

It is quite true that the way to live a godly life is not an easy matter. But the answer lies in Christ, who came to earth as a man, was proved spotless and pure in his Spirit, was **served** by angels, was preached among the nations, was accepted by men everywhere, and was received up again to his glory in heaven.

1 Timothy 6:2 AMP

Those who have believing masters are not to be disrespectful toward them because they are brothers [in Christ], but they should **serve** them even better, because those who benefit from their kindly service are believers and beloved. Teach and urge these [duties and principles].

2 Timothy 1:3 AMP

I thank God, whom I worship and **serve** with a clear conscience the way my forefathers did, as I constantly remember you in my prayers night and day,

2 Timothy 2:4 AMP

No soldier in active service gets entangled in the [ordinary business] affairs of civilian life; [he avoids them] so that he may please the one who enlisted him to **serve**.

Philemon 1:13 HCSB

I wanted to keep him with me, so that in my imprisonment for the gospel he might **serve** me in your place.

Hebrews 1:14 AMP

Are not all the angels ministering spirits sent out [by God] to **serve** (accompany, protect) those who will inherit salvation? [Of course they are!]

Hebrews 3:2 TLB

For Jesus was faithful to God who appointed him High Priest, just as Moses also faithfully **served** in God's house.

Hebrews 6:10 HCSB

For God is not unjust; He will not forget your work and the love you showed for His name when you **served** the saints-and you continue to **serve** them.

Hebrews 6:16 AMP

Indeed men swear [an oath] by one greater than themselves, and with them [in all disputes] the oath **serves** as confirmation [of what has been said] and is an end of the dispute.

Hebrews 7:13 AMP

For the One of whom these things are said belonged [not to the priestly line of Levi but] to another tribe, from which no one has officiated or **served** at the altar.

Hebrews 8:5 AMP

They **serve** as a pattern and foreshadowing of [what has its true existence and reality in] the heavenly things (sanctuary). For when Moses was about to erect the

tabernacle, he was warned by God, saying, "SEE THAT YOU MAKE it all [exactly] ACCORDING TO THE PATTERN WHICH WAS SHOWN TO YOU ON THE MOUNTAIN."

Hebrews 8:6 TLB

But Christ, as a Minister in heaven, has been rewarded with a far more important work than those who **serve** under the old laws because the new agreement that he passes on to us from God contains far more wonderful promises.

Hebrews 9:14 AMP

how much more will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal [Holy] Spirit willingly offered Himself unblemished [that is, without moral or spiritual imperfection as a sacrifice] to God, cleanse your conscience from dead works and lifeless observances to **serve** the ever living God?

Hebrews 12:28 HCSB

Therefore, since we are receiving a kingdom that cannot be shaken, let us hold on to grace. By it, we may **serve** God acceptably, with reverence and awe,

Hebrews 13:10 AMP

We have an altar from which those who **serve** the tabernacle (sacred tent) have no right to eat.

1 Peter 4:10 HCSB

Based on the gift each one has received, use it to **serve** others, as good managers of the varied grace of God.

1 Peter 4:11 AMP

Whoever speaks [to the congregation], is to do so as one who speaks the oracles (utterances, the very words) of God. Whoever **serves** [the congregation] is to do so as one who **serves** by the strength which God [abundantly] supplies, so that in all things God may be glorified [honored and magnified] through Jesus Christ, to whom belongs the glory and dominion forever and ever. Amen.

1 Peter 5:2 TLB

Feed the flock of God; care for it willingly, not grudgingly; not for what you will get out of it but because you are eager to **serve** the Lord.

1 Peter 5:5 TLB

You younger men, follow the leadership of those who are older. And all of you **serve** each other with humble spirits, for God gives special blessings to those who are humble, but sets himself against those who are proud.

Jude 1:7 HCSB

In the same way, Sodom and Gomorrah and the cities around them committed sexual immorality and practiced perversions, just as angels did, and **serve** as an example by undergoing the punishment of eternal fire.

Revelation 7:15 AMP

For this reason, they are [standing] before the throne of God; and they **serve** Him [in worship] day and night in His temple; and He who sits on the throne will spread His tabernacle over them and shelter and protect them [with His presence].

Revelation 22:3 AMP

There will no longer exist anything that is cursed [because sin and illness and death are gone]; and the throne of God and of the Lamb will be in it, and His bond-servants will **serve** and worship Him [with great awe and joy and loving devotion];
