Christmas Traditions From Around the World

Japan: Thanks to a 1970s marketing campaign, families often eat KFC on Christmas Eve, which is like Valentine's Day in the US, with couples going on dates and exchanging gifts.

Argentina: Since it is during their summer, families gather outdoors on December 24 for big meals and fireworks at midnight. Vitel Toné is a classic holiday dish of veal, tuna, and anchovy sauce.

Germany: December 24 is the main gift-giving night (Heiligabend), but children also leave out shoes to be filled with treats for St. Nikolaus Day (December 6).

Central Asia: The Russian Orthodox minority celebrates Christmas on January 7 as families enjoy simple gatherings with bread, pastries, and tea.

Philippines: Parol lanterns are star-shaped decorations made of bamboo and paper that are displayed during the holiday season to symbolize the Star of Bethlehem.

France: Réveillon is a lavish Christmas Eve dinner with cuisine such as oysters, foie gras (rich, buttery duck liver), and bûche de Noël (yule log cake).
