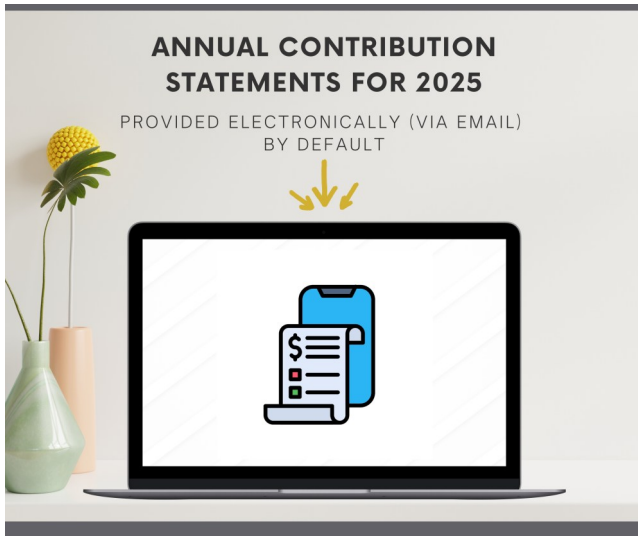
2026 BUDGET

On Sunday, January 18, after the 10:30 AM services in the Library, the Finance Team will be available to answer questions regarding our financial budget

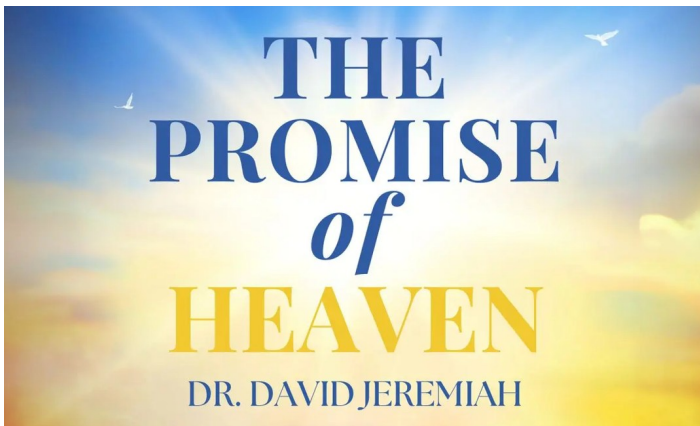
