The student **shares** his teacher's fate. The servant **shares** his master's! And since I, the master of the household, have been called 'Satan,' how much more will you!

Matthew 21:33 TLB

Acts 2:46 TLB

They worshiped together regularly at the Temple each day, met in small groups in homes for Communion, and **shared** their meals with great joy and thankfulness,

Acts 8:21 AMP

You have no part or **share** in this matter, because your heart (motive, purpose) is not right before God.

Acts 20:7 AMP

Now on the first day of the week (Sunday), when we were gathered together to break

bread (**share** communion), Paul began talking with them, intending to leave the next day; and he kept on with his message until midnight.

Acts 26:18 HCSB

Therefore, [inheriting] the promise depends entirely on faith [that is, confident trust in the unseen God], in order that it may be given as an act of grace [His unmerited favor and mercy], so that the promise will be [legally] guaranteed to all the descendants [of Abraham]—not only for those [Jewish believers] who keep the Law, but also for those [Gentile believers] who **share** the faith of Abraham, who is the [spiritual] father of us all—

Romans 6:5 AMP

For if we have become one with Him [permanently united] in the likeness of His death, we will also certainly be [one with Him and **share** fully] in the likeness of His resurrection.

Romans 6:8 TLB

And since your old sin-loving nature "died" with Christ, we know that you will **share** his new life.

Romans 8:17 AMP

And if [we are His] children, [then we are His] heirs also: heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ [sharing His spiritual blessing and inheritance], if indeed we **share** in His suffering so that we may also **share** in His glory.

Romans 8:20 TLB

For on that day thorns and thistles, sin, death, and decay—the things that overcame the world against its will at God's command—will all disappear, and the world around us will **share** in the glorious freedom from sin which God's children enjoy.

Romans 8:29 AMP

For those whom He foreknew [and loved and chose beforehand], He also predestined to be conformed to the image of His Son [and ultimately **share** in His complete

sanctification], so that He would be the firstborn [the most beloved and honored] among many believers.

Romans 11:12 TLB

Now if the whole world became rich as a result of God's offer of salvation, when the Jews stumbled over it and turned it down, think how much greater a blessing the world will **share** in later on when the Jews, too, come to Christ.

Romans 11:17 AMP

But if some of the branches were broken off, and you [Gentiles], being like a wild olive shoot, were grafted in among them to **share** with them the rich root of the olive tree,

Romans 11:31 TLB

And now the Jews are the rebels, but some day they, too, will **share** in God's mercy upon you.

Romans 12:13 HCSB

**Share** with the saints in their needs; pursue hospitality.

Romans 12:15 TLB

When others are happy, be happy with them. If they are sad, **share** their sorrow.

Romans 15:26 LSB

For Macedonia and Achaia were pleased to **share** with the poor among the saints in Jerusalem.

Romans 15:27 AMP

They were pleased to do it, and they are indebted to them. For if the Gentiles have come to **share** in their spiritual things, then they are indebted to serve them also in [tangible] material things.

1 Corinthians 6:9 AMP

Do you not know that the unrighteous will not inherit or have any **share** in the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived; neither the sexually immoral, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor (perversely) effeminate, nor homosexuals,

1 Corinthians 6:10 AMP

nor thieves, nor the greedy, nor drunkards, nor revilers [whose words are used as weapons to abuse, insult, humiliate, intimidate, or slander], nor swindlers will inherit or have any **share** in the kingdom of God.

1 Corinthians 7:4 AMP

The wife does not have [exclusive] authority over her own body, but the husband **shares** with her; and likewise the husband does not have [exclusive] authority over his body, but the wife **shares** with him.

1 Corinthians 9:10 TLB

Wasn't he also thinking about us? Of course he was. He said this to show us that Christian workers should be paid by those they help. Those who do the plowing and threshing should expect some **share** of the harvest.

1 Corinthians 9:12 AMP

If others **share** in this rightful claim over you, do not we even more? However, we did not exercise this right, but we put up with everything so that we will not hinder [the spread of] the good news of Christ.

1 Corinthians 9:13 AMP

Do you not know that those who officiate in the sacred services of the temple eat from the temple [offerings of meat and bread] and those who regularly attend the altar have their **share** from the [offerings brought to the] altar?

1 Corinthians 9:23 AMP

And I do all this for the sake of the gospel, so that I may **share** in its blessings along with you.

1 Corinthians 10:17 HCSB

Because there is one bread, we who are many are one body, for all of us **share** that one bread.

1 Corinthians 10:18 LSB

Look at the nation Israel. Are not those who eat the sacrifices **sharers** in the altar?

1 Corinthians 10:20 LSB

No, but I say that the things which the Gentiles sacrifice, they SACRIFICE TO DEMONS AND NOT TO GOD. And I do not want you to become **sharers** in demons.

1 Corinthians 10:21 AMP

You cannot drink [both] the Lord's cup and the cup of demons. You cannot **share** in both the Lord's table and the table of demons [thereby becoming partners with them].

1 Corinthians 10:30 AMP

If I take my **share** [of food] with thankfulness, why am I accused because of something for which I give thanks?

1 Corinthians 11:21 TLB

but your own. For I am told that everyone hastily gobbles all the food he can without waiting to **share** with the others, so that one doesn't get enough and goes hungry while another has too much to drink and gets drunk.

1 Corinthians 12:26 AMP

And if one member suffers, all the parts **share** the suffering; if one member is honored, all rejoice with it.

2 Corinthians 1:7 AMP

And our hope for you [our confident expectation of good for you] is firmly grounded [assured and unshaken], since we know that just as you **share** as partners in our sufferings, so also you **share** as partners in our comfort.

2 Corinthians 2:3 AMP

And I wrote this same thing to you, so that when I came, I would not be filled with sorrow by those who ought to make me glad, for I trusted in you and felt confident that my joy would be **shared** by all of you.

2 Corinthians 2:5 TLB

Remember that the man I wrote about, who caused all the trouble, has not caused sorrow to me as much as to all the rest of you-though I certainly have my **share** in it too. I don't want to be harder on him than I should. He has been punished enough by your united disapproval.

2 Corinthians 8:4 TLB

They begged us to take the money so they could **share** in the joy of helping the Christians in Jerusalem.

2 Corinthians 8:6 TLB

They were so enthusiastic about it that we have urged Titus, who encouraged your giving in the first place, to visit you and encourage you to complete your **share** in this ministry of giving.

2 Corinthians 8:14 TLB

but you should divide with them. Right now you have plenty and can help them; then at some other time they can **share** with you when you need it. In this way, each will have as much as he needs.

2 Corinthians 8:15 TLB

Do you remember what the Scriptures say about this? "He that gathered much had

nothing left over, and he that gathered little had enough." So you also should **share** with those in need.

2 Corinthians 11:8 AMP

I robbed other churches by accepting [more than their **share** of] financial support for my ministry to you.

Galatians 1:6 TLB

I am amazed that you are turning away so soon from God who, in his love and mercy, invited you to **share** the eternal life he gives through Christ; you are already following a different "way to heaven," which really doesn't go to heaven at all.

Galatians 2:20 AMP

I have been crucified with Christ [that is, in Him I have **shared** His crucifixion]; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me. The life I now live in the body I live by faith [by adhering to, relying on, and completely trusting] in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself up for me.

Galatians 3:8 TLB

What's more, the Scriptures looked forward to this time when God would save the Gentiles also, through their faith. God told Abraham about this long ago when he said, "I will bless those in every nation who trust in me as you do." And so it is: all who trust in Christ **share** the same blessing Abraham received.

Galatians 4:30 AMP

But what does the Scripture say? "CAST OUT THE BONDWOMAN [Hagar] AND HER SON [Ishmael], FOR NEVER SHALL THE SON OF THE BONDWOMAN BE HEIR and **SHARE** THE INHERITANCE WITH THE SON OF THE FREE WOMAN."

Galatians 6:2 TLB

**Share** each other's troubles and problems, and so obey our Lord's command.

Galatians 6:6 AMP

The one who is taught the word [of God] is to **share** all good things with his teacher [contributing to his spiritual and material support].

Ephesians 1:18 TLB

I pray that your hearts will be flooded with light so that you can see something of the future he has called you to **share**. I want you to realize that God has been made rich because we who are Christ's have been given to him!

Ephesians 2:12 AMP

remember that at that time you were separated from Christ [excluded from any relationship with Him], alienated from the commonwealth of Israel, and strangers to the covenants of promise [with no **share** in the sacred Messianic promise and without knowledge of God's agreements], having no hope [in His promise] and [living] in the world without God.

Ephesians 3:2 AMP

assuming that you have heard of the stewardship of God's grace that was entrusted to me [to **share** with you] for your benefit;

Ephesians 3:5 TLB

In olden times God did not **share** this plan with his people, but now he has revealed it by the Holy Spirit to his apostles and prophets.

Ephesians 3:6 TLB

And this is the secret: that the Gentiles will have their full **share** with the Jews in all the riches inherited by God's sons; both are invited to belong to his Church, and all of God's promises of mighty blessings through Christ apply to them both when they accept the Good News about Christ and what he has done for them.

Ephesians 4:16 NKJV

from whom the whole body, joined and knit together by what every joint supplies, according to the effective working by which every part does its **share**, causes growth of the body for the edifying of itself in love.

Ephesians 4:18 AMP

for their [moral] understanding is darkened and their reasoning is clouded; [they are] alienated and self-banished from the life of God [with no **share** in it; this is] because of the [willful] ignorance and spiritual blindness that is [deep-seated] within them, because of the hardness and insensitivity of their heart.

Ephesians 4:28 AMP

The thief [who has become a believer] must no longer steal, but instead he must work hard [making an honest living], producing that which is good with his own hands, so that he will have something to **share** with those in need.

Philippians 1:7 AMP

It is right for me to feel this way about you, because [you have me in your heart as] I have you in my heart, since both in my imprisonment and in the defense and



confirmation of the good news [regarding salvation], all of you **share** in [His matchless] grace with me.

Philippians 2:1 AMP

Therefore if there is any encouragement and comfort in Christ [as there certainly is in abundance], if there is any consolation of love, if there is any fellowship [that we **share**] in the Spirit, if [there is] any [great depth of] affection and compassion,

Philippians 2:17 AMP

But even if I am being poured out as a drink offering on the sacrifice and service of your faith [for preaching the message of salvation], still I rejoice and **share** my joy with you all.

Philippians 2:18 AMP

You too, rejoice in the same way and **share** your joy with me.

Philippians 3:10 AMP

And this, so that I may know Him [experientially, becoming more thoroughly acquainted with Him, understanding the remarkable wonders of His Person more completely] and [in that same way experience] the power of His resurrection [which overflows and is active in believers], and [that I may **share**] the fellowship of His sufferings, by being continually conformed [inwardly into His likeness even] to His death [dying as He did];

Philippians 4:3 AMP

Indeed, I ask you too, my true companion, to help these women [to keep on cooperating], for they have **shared** my struggle in the [cause of the] gospel, together with Clement and the rest of my fellow workers, whose names are in the Book of Life.

Philippians 4:14 AMP

Nevertheless, it was right of you to **share** [with me] in my difficulties.

Philippians 4:15 AMP

And you Philippians know that in the early days of preaching the gospel, after I left Macedonia, no church **shared** with me in the matter of giving and receiving except you alone;

Colossians 1:12 AMP

giving thanks to the Father, who has qualified us to **share** in the inheritance of the saints (God's people) in the Light.

Colossians 2:13 TLB

You were dead in sins, and your sinful desires were not yet cut away. Then he gave you a **share** in the very life of Christ, for he forgave all your sins,

Colossians 3:4 TLB

And when Christ who is our real life comes back again, you will shine with him and **share** in all his glories.

1 Thessalonians 2:8 AMP

Having such a deep affection for you, we were delighted to **share** with you not only God's good news but also our own lives, because you had become so very dear to us.

1 Thessalonians 2:12 TLB

that your daily lives should not embarrass God but bring joy to him who invited you into his Kingdom to **share** his glory.

2 Thessalonians 2:14 AMP

It was to this end that He called you through our gospel [the good news of Jesus' death, burial, and resurrection], so that you may obtain and **share** in the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ.

1 Timothy 4:3 AMP

who forbid marriage and advocate abstaining from [certain kinds of] foods which God has created to be gratefully **shared** by those who believe and have [a clear] knowledge of the truth.

1 Timothy 5:22 AMP

Do not hurry to lay hands on anyone [ordaining and approving someone for ministry or an office in the church, or in reinstating expelled offenders], and thereby **share** in the sins of others; keep yourself free from sin.

1 Timothy 6:18 AMP

Instruct them to do good, to be rich in good works, to be generous, willing to **share** [with others].

2 Timothy 1:8 AMP

So do not be ashamed to testify about our Lord or about me His prisoner, but with me take your **share** of suffering for the gospel [continue to preach regardless of the circumstances], in accordance with the power of God [for His power is invincible],

2 Timothy 2:3 AMP

Take with me your **share** of hardship [passing through the difficulties which you are

called to endure], like a good soldier of Christ Jesus.

2 Timothy 2:6 AMP

The hard-working farmer [who labors to produce crops] ought to be the first to receive his **share** of the crops.

Titus 3:7 TLB

so that he could declare us good in God's eyes—all because of his great kindness; and now we can **share** in the wealth of the eternal life he gives us, and we are eagerly looking forward to receiving it.

Philemon 1:6 TLB

And I pray that as you **share** your faith with others it will grip their lives too, as they see the wealth of good things in you that come from Christ Jesus.

Hebrews 2:14 AMP

Therefore, since [these His] children **share** in flesh and blood [the physical nature of mankind], He Himself in a similar manner also **shared** in the same [physical nature, but without sin], so that through [experiencing] death He might make powerless (ineffective, impotent) him who had the power of death—that is, the devil—

Hebrews 3:1 AMP

Therefore, holy brothers and sisters, who **share** in the heavenly calling, [thoughtfully and attentively] consider the Apostle and High Priest whom we confessed [as ours when we accepted Him as Savior], namely, Jesus;

Hebrews 3:14 TLB

For if we are faithful to the end, trusting God just as we did when we first became Christians, we will **share** in all that belongs to Christ.

Hebrews 6:4 AMP

For [it is impossible to restore to repentance] those who have once been enlightened [spiritually] and who have tasted and consciously experienced the heavenly gift and have **shared** in the Holy Spirit,

Hebrews 10:33 LSB

partly by being made a public spectacle through reproaches and afflictions, and partly by becoming **sharers** with those who were so treated.

Hebrews 11:24 TLB

It was by faith that Moses, when he grew up, refused to be treated as the grandson of

the king, but chose to **share** ill-treatment with God's people instead of enjoying the fleeting pleasures of sin.

Hebrews 11:40 TLB

for God wanted them to wait and **share** the even better rewards that were prepared for us.

Hebrews 12:8 AMP

Now if you are exempt from correction and without discipline, in which all [of God's children] **share**, then you are illegitimate children and not sons [at all].

Hebrews 12:10 AMP

For our earthly fathers disciplined us for only a short time as seemed best to them; but He disciplines us for our good, so that we may **share** His holiness.

Hebrews 13:3 TLB

Don't forget about those in jail. Suffer with them as though you were there yourself. **Share** the sorrow of those being mistreated, for you know what they are going through.

Hebrews 13:16 HCSB

Don't neglect to do what is good and to **share**, for God is pleased with such sacrifices.

1 Peter 4:9 TLB

Cheerfully **share** your home with those who need a meal or a place to stay for the night.

1 Peter 4:13 HCSB

Instead, rejoice as you **share** in the sufferings of the Messiah, so that you may also rejoice with great joy at the revelation of His glory.

1 Peter 5:1 AMP

Therefore, I strongly urge the elders among you [pastors, spiritual leaders of the church], as a fellow elder and as an eyewitness [called to testify] of the sufferings of Christ, as well as one who **shares** in the glory that is to be revealed:

1 Peter 5:4 TLB

and when the Head Shepherd comes, your reward will be a never-ending **share** in his glory and honor.

2 Peter 1:3 TLB

For as you know him better, he will give you, through his great power, everything you

need for living a truly good life: he even **shares** his own glory and his own goodness with us!

2 Peter 1:4 AMP

For by these He has bestowed on us His precious and magnificent promises [of inexpressible value], so that by them you may escape from the immoral freedom that is in the world because of disreputable desire, and become **share**rs of the divine nature.

1 John 1:3 TLB

Again I say, we are telling you about what we ourselves have actually seen and heard, so that you may **share** the fellowship and the joys we have with the Father and with Jesus Christ his son.

1 John 1:4 AMP

We are writing these things to you so that our joy [in seeing you included] may be made complete [by having you **share** in the joy of salvation].

2 John 1:11 HCSB

for the one who says, "Welcome," to him **shares** in his evil works.

Jude 1:3 HCSB

Dear friends, although I was eager to write you about the salvation we **share**, I found it necessary to write and exhort you to contend for the faith that was delivered to the saints once for all.

Revelation 1:9 TLB

It is I, your brother John, a fellow sufferer for the Lord's sake, who am writing this letter to you. I, too, have **shared** the patience Jesus gives, and we shall **share** his Kingdom! I was on the island of Patmos, exiled there for preaching the Word of God and for telling what I knew about Jesus Christ.

Revelation 14:8 TLB

Then another angel followed him through the skies, saying, "Babylon is fallen, is fallen-that great city-because she seduced the nations of the world and made them **share** the wine of her intense impurity and sin."

Revelation 18:4 HCSB

Then I heard another voice from heaven: Come out of her, My people, so that you will not **share** in her sins or receive any of her plagues.

Revelation 20:6 HCSB

Blessed and holy is the one who **shares** in the first resurrection! The second death has no power over them, but they will be priests of God and of the Messiah, and they will reign with Him for 1,000 years.

Revelation 21:8 HCSB

But the cowards, unbelievers, vile, murderers, sexually immoral, sorcerers, idolaters, and all liars-their **share** will be in the lake that burns with fire and sulfur, which is the second death."

and if anyone takes away from or distorts the words of the book of this prophecy, God will take away [from that one] his **share** from the tree of life and from the holy city (new Jerusalem), which are written in this book.
