Matthew 4:8 AMP

Again, the devil took Him up on a very high mountain and **showed** Him all the kingdoms of the world and the glory [splendor, magnificence, and excellence] of them;

Matthew 4:19 TLB

Jesus called out, "Come along with me and I will **show** you how to fish for the souls of men!"

Matthew 5:7 HCSB

The merciful are blessed, for they will be **shown** mercy.

Matthew 5:37 TLB

Say just a simple 'Yes, I will' or 'No, I won't.' Your word is enough. To strengthen your promise with a vow **shows** that something is wrong.

Matthew 5:45 AMP

so that you may [**show** yourselves to] be the children of your Father who is in heaven; for He makes His sun rise on those who are evil and on those who are good, and makes the rain fall on the righteous [those who are morally upright] and the unrighteous [the unrepentant, those who oppose Him].

Matthew 6:18 HCSB

so that you don't **show** your fasting to people but to your Father who is in secret. And your Father who sees in secret will reward you.

Matthew 8:4 AMP

And Jesus said to him, "See that you tell no one [about this]; but go, **show** yourself to the priest [for inspection] and present the offering that Moses commanded, as a testimony (evidence) to them [of your healing]."

Matthew 12:4 NKJV

how he entered the house of God and ate the **show**bread which was not lawful for him to eat, nor for those who were with him, but only for the priests?

Matthew 12:38 TLB

One day some of the Jewish leaders, including some Pharisees, came to Jesus asking him to **show** them a miracle.

Matthew 16:1 AMP

Now the Pharisees and Sadducees came up, and testing Jesus [to get something to use against Him], they asked Him to **show** them a sign from heaven [which would support His divine authority].

Matthew 16:21 AMP

From that time on Jesus began to **show** His disciples [clearly] that He must go to Jerusalem, and endure many things at the hands of the elders and the chief priests and scribes (Sanhedrin, Jewish High Court), and be killed, and be raised [from death to life] on the third day.

Matthew 18:15 AMP

"If your brother sins, go and **show** him his fault in private; if he listens and pays attention to you, you have won back your brother.

Matthew 22:1 TLB

Jesus told several other stories to **show** what the Kingdom of Heaven is like. "For instance," he said, "it can be illustrated by the story of a king who prepared a great wedding dinner for his son.

Matthew 22:16 HCSB

They sent their disciples to Him, with the Herodians. "Teacher," they said, "we know that You are truthful and teach truthfully the way of God. You defer to no one, for You don't **show** partiality.

Matthew 22:19 AMP

Show me the coin used for the poll-tax." And they brought Him a denarius [a day's wage].

Matthew 23:5 TLB

"Everything they do is done for **show**. They act holy by wearing on their arms little prayer boxes with Scripture verses inside, and by lengthening the memorial fringes of their robes.

Matthew 23:14 HCSB

["Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! You devour widows' houses and make long prayers just for **show**. This is why you will receive a harsher punishment.]

Matthew 24:1 NKJV

Then Jesus went out and departed from the temple, and His disciples came up to **show** Him the buildings of the temple.

Matthew 24:24 LSB

For false christs and false prophets will arise and will **show** great signs and wonders, so as to deceive, if possible, even the elect.

Matthew 27:41 TLB

And the chief priests and Jewish leaders also mocked him. "He saved others," they scoffed, "but he can't save himself! So you are the King of Israel, are you? Mark 7:19 TLB

For food doesn't come in contact with your heart, but only passes through the digestive system." (By saying this he **showed** that every kind of food is kosher.)

Mark 12:14 HCSB

When they came, they said to Him, "Teacher, we know You are truthful and defer to no one, for You don't **show** partiality but teach truthfully the way of God. Is it lawful to pay taxes to Caesar or not?"

Mark 12:15 TLB

Jesus saw their trick and said, "**Show** me a coin and I'll tell you."

Mark 12:40 HCSB

They devour widows' houses and say long prayers just for **show**. These will receive harsher punishment."

Mark 13:22 LSB

for false christs and false prophets will arise, and will **show** signs and wonders, in order to lead astray, if possible, the elect.

Mark 14:15 AMP

He will **show** you a large upstairs room, furnished and ready [with carpets and dining

couches]; prepare [the supper] for us there."

Mark 14:45 TLB

So as soon as they arrived he walked up to Jesus. "Master!" he exclaimed, and embraced him with a great **show** of friendliness.

Mark 14:70 NKJV

But he denied it again. And a little later those who stood by said to Peter again, "Surely you are one of them; for you are a Galilean, and your speech **shows** it."

Luke 1:51 NKJV

He has **shown** strength with His arm; He has scattered the proud in the imagination of their hearts.

To **show** mercy [as He promised] to our fathers, And to remember His holy covenant [the promised blessing],

for they assumed he was with friends among the other travelers. But when he didn't **show** up that evening, they started to look for him among their relatives and friends;

Luke 3:3 TLB

Then John went from place to place on both sides of the Jordan River, preaching that people should be baptized to **show** that they had turned to God and away from their sins, in order to be forgiven.

Luke 4:5 HCSB

So he took Him up and **showed** Him all the kingdoms of the world in a moment of time.

Luke 5:14 AMP

Jesus ordered him to tell no one [that he might happen to meet], "But go and **show** yourself to the priest, and make an offering for your purification, just as Moses commanded, as a testimony (witness) to them [that this is a work of Messiah]."

Luke 6:47 AMP

Everyone who comes to Me and listens to My words and obeys them, I will **show** you whom he is like:

Luke 7:35 AMP

Yet wisdom is vindicated and **shown** to be right by all her children [by the lifestyle, moral character, and good deeds of her followers]."

Luke 7:44 AMP

Then turning toward the woman, He said to Simon, "Do you see this woman? I came into your house [but you failed to extend to Me the usual courtesies **shown** to a guest]; you gave Me no water for My feet, but she has wet My feet with her tears and wiped them with her hair [demonstrating her love].

Luke 7:47 TLB

Therefore her sins-and they are many-are forgiven, for she loved me much; but one who is forgiven little, **shows** little love."

Luke 10:13 AMP

"Woe (judgment is coming) to you, Chorazin! Woe to you, Bethsaida! For if the miracles performed in you had been performed in Tyre and Sidon, they would have repented and changed their minds long ago, sitting in sackcloth and ashes [to **show** deep regret for sin].

Luke 10:37 AMP

He answered, "The one who **showed** compassion and mercy to him." Then Jesus said to him, "Go and constantly do the same."

Luke 12:5 HCSB

But I will **show** you the One to fear: Fear Him who has authority to throw people into hell after death. Yes, I say to you, this is the One to fear!

Luke 12:33 AMP

"Sell your possessions (**show** compassion) and give [donations] to the poor. Provide money belts for yourselves that do not wear out, an unfailing and inexhaustible treasure in the heavens, where no thief comes near and no moth destroys.

Luke 12:54 KJVS

And he said also to the people, When ye see a cloud rise out of the west, straightway ye say, There cometh a **shower**; and so it is.

Luke 14:8 TLB

"If you are invited to a wedding feast, don't always head for the best seat. For if someone more respected than you **shows** up,

Luke 16:13 TLB

"For neither you nor anyone else can serve two masters. You will hate one and **show** loyalty to the other, or else the other way around-you will be enthusiastic about one and despise the other. You cannot serve both God and money."

Luke 17:14 AMP

When He saw them, He said to them, "Go and **show** yourselves to the priests." And as they went, they were [miraculously] healed and made clean.

Luke 18:1 LSB

Now He was telling them a parable to **show** that at all times they ought to pray and not to lose heart,

Luke 19:9 TLB

Jesus told him, "This **shows** that salvation has come to this home today. This man was one of the lost sons of Abraham, and I, the Messiah, have come to search for and to save such souls as his."

Luke 20:13 TLB

Luke 20:21 AMP

Luke 20:47 HCSB

They devour widows' houses and say long prayers just for **show**. These will receive greater punishment."

Luke 22:11 TLB

and say to the man who lives there, 'Our Teacher says for you to **show** us the guest room where he can eat the Passover meal with his disciples.'

Luke 22:12 AMP

Then he will **show** you a large upstairs room, furnished [with carpets and dining couches]; prepare the meal there."

Luke 24:40 AMP

After saying this, He **showed** them His hands and His feet.

John 2:18 AMP

Then the Jews retorted, "What sign (attesting miracle) can You **show** us as [proof of] your authority for doing these things?"

John 3:21 AMP

But whoever practices truth [and does what is right—morally, ethically, spiritually] comes to the Light, so that his works may be plainly **shown** to be what they are—accomplished in God [divinely prompted, done with God's help, in dependence on Him]."

John 5:20 AMP

For the Father dearly loves the Son and **shows** Him everything that He Himself is doing; and the Father will **show** Him greater works than these, so that you will be filled with wonder.

John 5:35 AMP

John was the lamp that kept on burning and shining [to **show** you the way], and you were willing for a while to rejoice in his light.

John 6:30 TLB

They replied, "You must **show** us more miracles if you want us to believe you are the Messiah. Give us free bread every day, like our fathers had while they journeyed through the wilderness! As the Scriptures say, 'Moses gave them bread from heaven.'"

John 7:4 AMP

No one does anything in secret when he wants to be known publicly. If You [must] do these things, **show** Yourself openly to the world and make Yourself known!"

John 9:39 TLB

Then Jesus told him, "I have come into the world to give sight to those who are spiritually blind and to **show** those who think they see that they are blind."

John 10:32 AMP

Jesus answered them, "I **showed** you many good works [and many acts of mercy] from the Father; for which of them are you stoning Me?"

John 12:38 AMP

This was to fulfill what Isaiah the prophet said: "LORD, WHO HAS BELIEVED OUR MESSAGE? AND TO WHOM HAS THE ARM (the power) OF THE LORD BEEN **SHOWN** (unveiled, revealed)?"

John 14:8 AMP

Philip said to Him, "Lord, **show** us the Father and then we will be satisfied."

John 14:9 AMP

Jesus said to him, "Have I been with you for so long a time, and you do not know Me yet, Philip, nor recognize clearly who I am? Anyone who has seen Me has seen the Father. How can you say, '**Show** us the Father?'

John 15:13 TLB

And here is how to measure it-the greatest love is **shown** when a person lays down his life for his friends;

John 16:14 TLB

He shall praise me and bring me great honor by **showing** you my glory.

John 16:15 TLB

All the Father's glory is mine; this is what I mean when I say that he will **show** you my glory.

John 20:20 AMP

After He said this, He **showed** them His hands and His side. When the disciples saw the Lord, they were filled with great joy.

John 21:1 NKJV

After these things Jesus **showed** Himself again to the disciples at the Sea of Tiberias, and in this way He **showed** Himself:

John 21:14 NKJV

This is now the third time Jesus **showed** Himself to His disciples after He was raised from the dead.

Acts 1:3 AMP

To these [men] He also **showed** Himself alive after His suffering [in Gethsemane and on the cross], by [a series of] many infallible proofs and unquestionable demonstrations, appearing to them over a period of forty days and talking to them about the things concerning the kingdom of God.

Acts 1:24 AMP

They prayed and said, "You, Lord, who know all hearts [their thoughts, motives, desires], **show** us which one of these two You have chosen

Acts 2:19 NKJV

I will **show** wonders in heaven above And signs in the earth beneath: Blood and fire and vapor of smoke.

Acts 7:3 AMP

and He said to him, 'LEAVE YOUR COUNTRY AND YOUR RELATIVES, AND COME TO THE LAND THAT I WILL **SHOW** YOU.'

Acts 7:26 HCSB

The next day he **showed** up while they were fighting and tried to reconcile them peacefully, saying, 'Men, you are brothers. Why are you mistreating each other?'

Acts 7:36 NKJV

He brought them out, after he had **shown** wonders and signs in the land of Egypt, and in the Red Sea, and in the wilderness forty years.

Acts 7:44 TLB

"Our ancestors carried along with them a portable Temple, or Tabernacle, through the wilderness. In it they kept the stone tablets with the Ten Commandments written on

them. This building was constructed in exact accordance with the plan **shown** to Moses by the Angel.

Acts 9:12 TLB

I have **shown** him a vision of a man named Ananias coming in and laying his hands on him so that he can see again!"

Acts 9:16 HCSB

I will **show** him how much he must suffer for My name!"

Acts 9:39 AMP

So Peter got up [at once] and went with them. When he arrived, they brought him into the upstairs room; and all the widows stood beside him, weeping and **showing** [him] all the tunics and robes that Dorcas used to make while she was with them.

Acts 10:28 AMP

He said to them, "You know that it is unlawful for a Jewish man to associate with or befriend a Gentile, or to visit him; and yet God has **shown** me that I am not to call anyone common or [ceremonially] unclean.

Acts 10:34 AMP

Opening his mouth, Peter said: "Most certainly I understand now that God is not one to **show** partiality [to people as though Gentiles were excluded from God's blessing],

Acts 10:40 NKJV

Him God raised up on the third day, and **showed** Him openly,

Acts 11:28 NKJV

Then one of them, named Agabus, stood up and **showed** by the Spirit that there was going to be a great famine throughout all the world, which also happened in the days of Claudius Caesar.

Acts 13:46 TLB

Then Paul and Barnabas spoke out boldly and declared, "It was necessary that this Good News from God should be given first to you Jews. But since you have rejected it and **shown** yourselves unworthy of eternal life—well, we will offer it to Gentiles.

Acts 14:17 AMP

yet He did not leave Himself without some witness [as evidence of Himself], in that He kept constantly doing good things and **showing** you kindness, and giving you rains from heaven and productive seasons, filling your hearts with food and happiness."

Acts 17:3 HCSB

explaining and **showing** that the Messiah had to suffer and rise from the dead: "This Jesus I am proclaiming to you is the Messiah."

Acts 18:28 NKJV

for he vigorously refuted the Jews publicly, **showing** from the Scriptures that Jesus is the Christ.

Acts 20:35 AMP

In everything I **showed** you [by example] that by working hard in this way you must help the weak and remember the words of the Lord Jesus, that He Himself said, 'It is more blessed [and brings greater joy] to give than to receive.'"

Acts 28:2 AMP

And the natives **showed** us extraordinary kindness and hospitality; for they kindled a fire and welcomed us all, since it had begun to rain and was cold.

Acts 28:10 TLB

As a result we were **showered** with gifts, and when the time came to sail, people put on board all sorts of things we would need for the trip.

Romans 1:18 TLB

But God **shows** his anger from heaven against all sinful, evil men who push away the truth from them.

Romans 1:19 HCSB

since what can be known about God is evident among them, because God has **shown** it to them.

Romans 1:21 HCSB

For though they knew God, they did not glorify Him as God or **show** gratitude. Instead, their thinking became nonsense, and their senseless minds were darkened.

Romans 2:11 AMP

For God **shows** no partiality [no arbitrary favoritism; with Him one person is not more important than another].

Romans 2:15 AMP

They **show** that the essential requirements of the Law are written in their hearts; and their conscience [their sense of right and wrong, their moral choices] bearing witness and their thoughts alternately accusing or perhaps defending them

Romans 3:9 TLB

Well, then, are we Jews better than others? No, not at all, for we have already **shown** that all men alike are sinners, whether Jews or Gentiles.

Romans 3:21 TLB

But now God has **shown** us a different way to heaven-not by "being good enough" and trying to keep his laws, but by a new way (though not new, really, for the Scriptures told about it long ago). Now God says he will accept and acquit us-declare us "not guilty"-if we trust Jesus Christ to take away our sins. And we all can be saved in this same way, by coming to Christ, no matter who we are or what we have been like.

Romans 5:8 AMP

But God clearly **shows** and proves His own love for us, by the fact that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

Romans 6:1 TLB

Well then, shall we keep on sinning so that God can keep on **showing** us more and more kindness and forgiveness?

Romans 7:7 TLB

Well then, am I suggesting that these laws of God are evil? Of course not! No, the law is not sinful, but it was the law that **showed** me my sin. I would never have known the sin in my heart-the evil desires that are hidden there-if the law had not said, "You must not have evil desires in your heart."

Romans 7:10 TLB

So as far as I was concerned, the good law which was supposed to **show** me the way of life resulted instead in my being given the death penalty.

Romans 7:13 LSB

Therefore did that which is good become a cause of death for me? May it never be! Rather it was sin, in order that it might be **shown** to be sin by working out my death through that which is good, so that through the commandment sin would become utterly sinful.

Romans 9:15 HCSB

For He tells Moses: I will **show** mercy to whom I will **show** mercy, and I will have compassion on whom I will have compassion.

Romans 9:16 AMP

So then God's choice is not dependent on human will, nor on human effort [the

totality of human striving], but on God who **shows** mercy [to whomever He chooses—it is His sovereign gift].

Romans 9:17 NKJV

For the Scripture says to the Pharaoh, "For this very purpose I have raised you up, that I may **show** My power in you, and that My name may be declared in all the earth."

Romans 9:18 HCSB

So then, He **shows** mercy to those He wants to, and He hardens those He wants to harden.

Romans 9:22 AMP

What if God, although willing to **show** His [terrible] wrath and to make His power known, has tolerated with great patience the objects of His wrath [which are] prepared for destruction?

Romans 10:20 AMP

Then Isaiah is very bold and says, "I HAVE BEEN FOUND BY THOSE WHO DID NOT SEEK ME; I HAVE **SHOWN** MYSELF TO THOSE WHO DID NOT [consciously] ASK FOR ME."

Romans 11:30 LSB

For just as you once were disobedient to God, but now have been **shown** mercy because of their disobedience,

Romans 11:31 AMP

so they too have now become disobedient so that they too may one day receive mercy because of the mercy **shown** to you.

Romans 11:32 AMP

For God has imprisoned all in disobedience so that He may **show** mercy to all [Jew and Gentile alike].

Romans 12:8 AMP

or he who encourages, in the act of encouragement; he who gives, with generosity; he who leads, with diligence; he who **shows** mercy [in caring for others], with cheerfulness.

Romans 12:10 HCSB

Show family affection to one another with brotherly love. Outdo one another in **showing** honor.

Romans 14:10 NKJV

But why do you judge your brother? Or why do you **show** contempt for your brother? For we shall all stand before the judgment seat of Christ.

Romans 15:8 TLB

Remember that Jesus Christ came to **show** that God is true to his promises and to help the Jews.

1 Corinthians 1:20 TLB

So what about these wise men, these scholars, these brilliant debaters of this world's great affairs? God has made them all look foolish and **shown** their wisdom to be useless nonsense.

1 Corinthians 1:30 TLB

For it is from God alone that you have your life through Christ Jesus. He **showed** us God's plan of salvation; he was the one who made us acceptable to God; he made us pure and holy and gave himself to purchase our salvation.

1 Corinthians 2:10 TLB

But we know about these things because God has sent his Spirit to tell us, and his Spirit searches out and **shows** us all of God's deepest secrets.

1 Corinthians 3:4 TLB

There you are, quarreling about whether I am greater than Apollos, and dividing the church. Doesn't this **show** how little you have grown in the Lord?

1 Corinthians 3:13 AMP

each one's work will be clearly **shown** [for what it is]; for the day [of judgment] will disclose it, because it is to be revealed with fire, and the fire will test the quality and character and worth of each person's work.

1 Corinthians 4:9 AMP

For, I think, God has exhibited us apostles at the end of the line, like men sentenced to death [and paraded as prisoners in a procession], because we have become a spectacle to the world [a **show** in the world's amphitheater], both to angels and to men.

1 Corinthians 8:2 TLB

If anyone thinks he knows all the answers, he is just **showing** his ignorance.

1 Corinthians 9:10 TLB

Wasn't he also thinking about us? Of course he was. He said this to **show** us that

Christian workers should be paid by those they help. Those who do the plowing and threshing should expect some share of the harvest.

1 Corinthians 10:13 TLB

But remember this-the wrong desires that come into your life aren't anything new and different. Many others have faced exactly the same problems before you. And no temptation is irresistible. You can trust God to keep the temptation from becoming so strong that you can't stand up against it, for he has promised this and will do what he says. He will **show** you how to escape temptation's power so that you can bear up patiently against it.

1 Corinthians 10:16 TLB

When we ask the Lord's blessing upon our drinking from the cup of wine at the Lord's Table, this means, doesn't it, that all who drink it are sharing together the blessing of Christ's blood? And when we break off pieces of the bread from the loaf to eat there together, this **shows** that we are sharing together in the benefits of his body.

1 Corinthians 10:17 TLB

No matter how many of us there are, we all eat from the same loaf, **showing** that we are all parts of the one body of Christ.

1 Corinthians 11:22 AMP

What! Do you not have houses in which to eat and drink? Or do you **show** contempt for the church of God and humiliate those [impoverished believers] who have nothing? What will I say to you? Shall I praise you for this? In this I will not praise you!

1 Corinthians 12:31 AMP

But earnestly desire and strive for the greater gifts [if acquiring them is going to be your goal]. And yet I will **show** you a still more excellent way [one of the choicest graces and the highest of them all: unselfish love].

2 Corinthians 1:5 TLB

You can be sure that the more we undergo sufferings for Christ, the more he will **show** us with his comfort and encouragement.

2 Corinthians 1:6 TLB

We are in deep trouble for bringing you God's comfort and salvation. But in our trouble God has comforted us-and this, too, to help you: to **show** you from our personal experience how God will tenderly comfort you when you undergo these same sufferings. He will give you the strength to endure.

2 Corinthians 2:4 TLB

Oh, how I hated to write that letter! It almost broke my heart, and I tell you honestly that I cried over it. I didn't want to hurt you, but I had to **show** you how very much I loved you and cared about what was happening to you.

2 Corinthians 2:8 TLB

Please **show** him now that you still do love him very much.

2 Corinthians 3:3 AMP

You **show** that you are a letter from Christ, delivered by us, written not with ink but with the Spirit of the living God, not on tablets of stone but on tablets of human hearts.

2 Corinthians 4:1 HCSB

Therefore, since we have this ministry because we were **shown** mercy, we do not give up.

2 Corinthians 4:7 AMP

But we have this precious treasure [the good news about salvation] in [unworthy] earthen vessels [of human frailty], so that the grandeur and surpassing greatness of the power will be [**shown** to be] from God [His sufficiency] and not from ourselves.

2 Corinthians 4:10 AMP

always carrying around in the body the dying of Jesus, so that the [resurrection] life of Jesus also may be **shown** in our body.

2 Corinthians 4:11 TLB

Yes, we live under constant danger to our lives because we serve the Lord, but this gives us constant opportunities to **show** forth the power of Jesus Christ within our dying bodies.

2 Corinthians 6:4 TLB

In fact, in everything we do we try to **show** that we are true ministers of God. We patiently endure suffering and hardship and trouble of every kind.

2 Corinthians 7:11 HCSB

For consider how much diligence this very thing-this grieving as God wills-has produced in you: what a desire to clear yourselves, what indignation, what fear, what deep longing, what zeal, what justice! In every way you **showed** yourselves to be pure in this matter.

2 Corinthians 7:12 TLB

I wrote as I did so the Lord could **show** how much you really do care for us. That was my purpose even more than to help the man who sinned or his father to whom he did the wrong.

2 Corinthians 8:19 AMP

and not only this, but he has also been appointed by the churches to travel with us in regard to this gracious offering which we are administering for the glory of the Lord Himself, and to **show** our eagerness [as believers to help one another].

2 Corinthians 8:24 AMP

Therefore, **show** these men, in the sight of the churches, the proof of your love and our reason for being proud of you.

2 Corinthians 9:10 AMP

Now He who provides seed for the sower and bread for food will provide and multiply your seed for sowing [that is, your resources] and increase the harvest of your righteousness [which **shows** itself in active goodness, kindness, and love].

2 Corinthians 9:14 TLB

And they will pray for you with deep fervor and feeling because of the wonderful grace of God **shown** through you.

2 Corinthians 10:2 AMP

I ask that when I do come I will not be driven to the boldness that I intend to **show** toward those few who regard us as if we walked according to the flesh [like men without the Spirit].

2 Corinthians 11:4 TLB

You seem so gullible: you believe whatever anyone tells you even if he is preaching about another Jesus than the one we preach, or a different spirit than the Holy Spirit you received, or **shows** you a different way to be saved. You swallow it all.

2 Corinthians 11:30 TLB

But if I must brag, I would rather brag about the things that **show** how weak I am.

2 Corinthians 12:9 AMP

but He has said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you [My lovingkindness and My mercy are more than enough—always available—regardless of the situation]; for [My] power is being perfected [and is completed and **shows** itself most effectively] in [your] weakness." Therefore, I will all the more gladly boast in my weaknesses, so that the power of Christ [may completely enfold me and] may dwell in me.

Galatians 1:7 TLB

For there is no other way than the one we **showed** you; you are being fooled by those who twist and change the truth concerning Christ.

Galatians 1:16 TLB

to reveal his Son within me so that I could go to the Gentiles and **show** them the Good News about Jesus. When all this happened to me I didn't go at once and talk it over with anyone else;

Galatians 2:6 AMP

But from those who were of high reputation (whatever they were—in terms of individual importance—makes no difference to me; God **shows** no partiality—He is not impressed with the positions that people hold nor does He recognize distinctions such as fame or power)—well, those who were of reputation contributed nothing to me [that is, they had nothing to add to my gospel message nor did they impose any new requirements on me].

Galatians 2:18 HCSB

If I rebuild the system I tore down, I **show** myself to be a lawbreaker.

Galatians 3:19 TLB

Well then, why were the laws given? They were added after the promise was given, to **show** men how guilty they are of breaking God's laws. But this system of law was to last only until the coming of Christ, the Child to whom God's promise was made. (And there is this further difference. God gave his laws to angels to give to Moses, who then gave them to the people;

But if instead of **showing** love among yourselves you are always critical and catty, watch out! Beware of ruining each other.

Galatians 6:12 LSB

As many as are wanting to make a good **showing** in the flesh, these are trying to compel you to be circumcised, simply so that they will not be persecuted for the cross of Christ.

Ephesians 1:8 TLB

and he has **showed** down upon us the richness of his grace—for how well he understands us and knows what is best for us at all times.

Ephesians 2:7 AMP

[and He did this] so that in the ages to come He might [clearly] **show** the

immeasurable and unsurpassed riches of His grace in [His] kindness toward us in Christ Jesus [by providing for our redemption].

Ephesians 3:2 TLB

No doubt you already know that God has given me this special work of **showing** God's favor to you Gentiles, as I briefly mentioned before in one of my letters. God himself **showed** me this secret plan of his, that the Gentiles, too, are included in his kindness.

And his reason? To **show** to all the rulers in heaven how perfectly wise he is when all of his family-Jews and Gentiles alike-are seen to be joined together in his Church

And you husbands, **show** the same kind of love to your wives as Christ **showed** to the Church when he died for her,

Ephesians 6:4 AMP

Fathers, do not provoke your children to anger [do not exasperate them to the point of resentment with demands that are trivial or unreasonable or humiliating or abusive; nor by **showing** favoritism or indifference to any of them], but bring them up [tenderly, with lovingkindness] in the discipline and instruction of the Lord.

Ephesians 6:9 AMP

You masters, do the same [**showing** goodwill] toward them, and give up threatening and abusive words, knowing that [He who is] both their true Master and yours is in heaven, and that there is no partiality with Him [regardless of one's earthly status].

Philippians 1:11 TLB

May you always be doing those good, kind things that **show** you are a child of God, for this will bring much praise and glory to the Lord.

Philippians 2:5 TLB

Your attitude should be the kind that was **shown** us by Jesus Christ,

Philippians 2:29 TLB

Welcome him in the Lord with great joy, and **show** your appreciation,

Philippians 4:10 AMP

I rejoiced greatly in the Lord, that now at last you have renewed your concern for me; indeed, you were concerned about me before, but you had no opportunity to **show** it.

Colossians 1:2 TLB

To: The faithful Christian brothers-God's people-in the city of Colosse. May God our Father **show** you with blessings and fill you with his great peace.

Colossians 4:1 LSB

Masters, **show** to your slaves what is right and fair, knowing that you too have a Master in heaven.

1 Thessalonians 2:15 AMP

who killed both the Lord Jesus and the prophets, and harassed and drove us out; and [they] continue to be highly displeasing to God and [to **show** themselves] hostile to all people,

2 Thessalonians 2:4 NKJV

who opposes and exalts himself above all that is called God or that is worshiped, so that he sits as God in the temple of God, **showing** himself that he is God.

2 Thessalonians 3:9 TLB

It wasn't that we didn't have the right to ask you to feed us, but we wanted to **show** you firsthand how you should work for your living.

I, Paul, write you this final greeting with my own hand. This is the distinguishing mark in every letter [of mine, that **shows** it is genuine]. It is the way I write [my handwriting and signature].

To: Timothy. Timothy, you are like a son to me in the things of the Lord. May God our Father and Jesus Christ our Lord **show** you his kindness and mercy and give you great peace of heart and mind.

1 Timothy 1:7 TLB

They want to become famous as teachers of the laws of Moses when they haven't the slightest idea what those laws really **show** us.

1 Timothy 1:13 AMP

even though I was formerly a blasphemer [of our Lord] and a persecutor [of His church] and a shameful and outrageous and violent aggressor [toward believers]. Yet I was **shown** mercy because I acted out of ignorance in unbelief.

1 Timothy 1:14 TLB

Oh, how kind our Lord was, for he **showed** me how to trust him and become full of the love of Christ Jesus.

1 Timothy 1:16 LSB

Yet for this reason I was **shown** mercy, so that in me as the foremost, Christ Jesus might demonstrate all His patience as an example for those who are going to believe upon Him for eternal life.

1 Timothy 2:7 TLB

And I have been chosen-this is the absolute truth-as God's minister and missionary to teach this truth to the Gentiles and to **show** them God's plan of salvation through faith.

Alexander the coppersmith **showed** me much harm; the Lord will award him according to his deeds.

Their belief in the truth that they have been taught must be strong and steadfast so that they will be able to teach it to others and **show** those who disagree with them where they are wrong.

Titus 2:7 AMP

And in all things **show** yourself to be an example of good works, with purity in doctrine [having the strictest regard for integrity and truth], dignified,

Titus 2:10 NKJV

not pilfering, but **showing** all good fidelity, that they may adorn the doctrine of God our Savior in all things.

Titus 3:2 AMP

to slander or abuse no one, to be kind and conciliatory and gentle, **showing** unqualified consideration and courtesy toward everyone.

Philemon 1:10 TLB

My plea is that you **show** kindness to my child Onesimus, whom I won to the Lord while here in my chains.

Hebrews 2:4 TLB

God always has **shown** us that these messages are true by signs and wonders and various miracles and by giving certain special abilities from the Holy Spirit to those who believe; yes, God has assigned such gifts to each of us.

Hebrews 5:12 TLB

You have been Christians a long time now, and you ought to be teaching others, but instead you have dropped back to the place where you need someone to teach you all over again the very first principles in God's Word. You are like babies who can drink only milk, not old enough for solid food. And when a person is still living on milk it **shows** he isn't very far along in the Christian life, and doesn't know much about the difference between right and wrong. He is still a baby Christian!

Hebrews 6:7 TLB

When a farmer's land has had many **showers** upon it and good crops come up, that land has experienced God's blessing upon it.

Hebrews 6:10 AMP

For God is not unjust so as to forget your work and the love which you have **shown** for His name in ministering to [the needs of] the saints (God's people), as you do.

Hebrews 6:11 AMP

And we desire for each one of you to **show** the same diligence [all the way through] so as to realize and enjoy the full assurance of hope until the end,

Hebrews 6:17 AMP

In the same way God, in His desire to **show** to the heirs of the promise the unchangeable nature of His purpose, intervened and guaranteed it with an oath,

Hebrews 8:5 AMP

They serve as a pattern and foreshadowing of [what has its true existence and reality in] the heavenly things (sanctuary). For when Moses was about to erect the tabernacle, he was warned by God, saying, "SEE THAT YOU MAKE it all [exactly] ACCORDING TO THE PATTERN WHICH WAS **SHOWN** TO YOU ON THE MOUNTAIN."

Hebrews 8:8 AMP

However, God finds fault with them [**showing** its inadequacy] when He says, "BEHOLD, THE DAYS WILL COME, SAYS THE LORD, WHEN I WILL MAKE and RATIFY A NEW COVENANT WITH THE HOUSE OF ISRAEL AND WITH THE HOUSE OF JUDAH;

Hebrews 9:2 AMP

A tabernacle (sacred tent) was put up, the outer one or first section, in which were the lampstand and the table with [its loaves of] the sacred **showbread**; this is called the Holy Place.

Hebrews 10:34 AMP

For you **showed** sympathy and deep concern for those who were imprisoned, and you joyfully accepted the [unjust] seizure of your belongings and the confiscation of your property, conscious of the fact that you have a better possession and a lasting one [prepared for you in heaven].

Hebrews 12:5 TLB

And have you quite forgotten the encouraging words God spoke to you, his child? He said, "My son, don't be angry when the Lord punishes you. Don't be discouraged when he has to **show** you where you are wrong.

Hebrews 12:28 AMP

Therefore, since we receive a kingdom which cannot be shaken, let us **show** gratitude, and offer to God pleasing service and acceptable worship with reverence and awe;

Hebrews 13:2 HCSB

Don't neglect to **show** hospitality, for by doing this some have welcomed angels as guests without knowing it.

James 2:1 AMP

My fellow believers, do not practice your faith in our glorious Lord Jesus Christ with an attitude of partiality [toward people—**show** no favoritism, no prejudice, no snobbery].

James 2:4 NKJV

have you not **shown** partiality among yourselves, and become judges with evil thoughts?

James 2:9 AMP

But if you **show** partiality [prejudice, favoritism], you are committing sin and are convicted by the Law as offenders.

James 2:13 AMP

For judgment will be merciless to one who has **shown** no mercy; but [to the one who has **shown** mercy] mercy triumphs [victoriously] over judgment.

James 2:17 TLB

So you see, it isn't enough just to have faith. You must also do good to prove that you have it. Faith that doesn't **show** itself by good works is no faith at all-it is dead and useless.

James 2:18 AMP

But someone may say, "You [claim to] have faith and I have [good] works; **show** me your [alleged] faith without the works [if you can], and I will **show** you my faith by my works [that is, by what I do]."

James 2:21 AMP

Was our father Abraham not [**shown** to be] justified by works [of obedience which expressed his faith] when he offered Isaac his son on the altar [as a sacrifice to God]?

James 3:13 AMP

Who among you is wise and intelligent? Let him by his good conduct **show** his [good] deeds with the gentleness and humility of true wisdom.

1 Peter 2:9 TLB

But you are not like that, for you have been chosen by God himself-you are priests of the King, you are holy and pure, you are God's very own-all this so that you may **show** to others how God called you out of the darkness into his wonderful light.

1 Peter 2:17 AMP

Show respect for all people [treat them honorably], love the brotherhood [of believers], fear God, honor the king.

1 Peter 3:7 AMP

In the same way, you husbands, live with your wives in an understanding way [with great gentleness and tact, and with an intelligent regard for the marriage relationship], as with someone physically weaker, since she is a woman. **Show** her honor and respect as a fellow heir of the grace of life, so that your prayers will not be hindered or ineffective.

1 Peter 3:21 TLB

(That, by the way, is what baptism pictures for us: In baptism we **show** that we have been saved from death and doom by the resurrection of Christ; not because our

bodies are washed clean by the water but because in being baptized we are turning to God and asking him to cleanse our hearts from sin.)

Most important of all, continue to **show** deep love for each other, for love makes up for many of your faults.

2 Peter 1:13 TLB

But the Lord Jesus Christ has **shown** me that my days here on earth are numbered, and I am soon to die. As long as I am still here I intend to keep sending these reminders to you,

2 Peter 1:14 HCSB

knowing that I will soon lay aside my tent, as our Lord Jesus Christ has also **shown** me.

1 John 1:2 TLB

This one who is life from God has been **shown** to us, and we guarantee that we have seen him; I am speaking of Christ, who is eternal Life. He was with the Father and then was **shown** to us.

1 John 2:15 TLB

Stop loving this evil world and all that it offers you, for when you love these things you **show** that you do not really love God;

1 John 2:19 AMP

They went out from us [seeming at first to be Christians], but they were not really of us [because they were not truly born again and spiritually transformed]; for if they had been of us, they would have remained with us; but they went out [teaching false doctrine], so that it would be clearly **shown** that none of them are of us.

1 John 3:1 AMP

See what an incredible quality of love the Father has **shown** to us, that we would [be permitted to] be named and called and counted the children of God! And so we are! For this reason the world does not know us, because it did not know Him.

1 John 3:8 TLB

But if you keep on sinning, it **shows** that you belong to Satan, who since he first began to sin has kept steadily at it. But the Son of God came to destroy these works of the devil.

1 John 3:10 TLB

So now we can tell who is a child of God and who belongs to Satan. Whoever is living a life of sin and doesn't love his brother **shows** that he is not in God's family;

1 John 3:18 TLB

Little children, let us stop just saying we love people; let us really love them, and **show** it by our actions.

1 John 4:7 TLB

Dear friends, let us practice loving each other, for love comes from God and those who are loving and kind **show** that they are the children of God, and that they are getting to know him better.

1 John 4:8 TLB

But if a person isn't loving and kind, it **shows** that he doesn't know God-for God is love.

1 John 4:9 TLB

God **showed** how much he loved us by sending his only Son into this wicked world to bring to us eternal life through his death.

1 John 4:18 TLB

We need have no fear of someone who loves us perfectly; his perfect love for us eliminates all dread of what he might do to us. If we are afraid, it is for fear of what he might do to us and **shows** that we are not fully convinced that he really loves us.

3 John 1:5 HCSB

Dear friend, you are **showing** faithfulness by whatever you do for the brothers, especially when they are strangers.

Jude 1:16 TLB

These men are constant gripers, never satisfied, doing whatever evil they feel like; they are loudmouthed "**show**-offs," and when they **show** respect for others, it is only to get something from them in return.

Revelation 1:1 AMP

This is the revelation of Jesus Christ [His unveiling of the divine mysteries], which God [the Father] gave to Him to **show** to His bond-servants (believers) the things which must soon take place [in their entirety]; and He sent and communicated it by His angel (divine messenger) to His bond-servant John,

Revelation 1:19 TLB

Write down what you have just seen and what will soon be **shown** to you.

Revelation 3:19 AMP

Those whom I [dearly and tenderly] love, I rebuke and discipline [**showing** them their faults and instructing them]; so be enthusiastic and repent [change your inner self—your old way of thinking, your sinful behavior—seek God's will].

Revelation 4:1 AMP

After this I looked, and behold, a door standing open in heaven! And the first voice which I had heard, like the sound of a [war] trumpet speaking with me, said, "Come up here, and I will **show** you what must take place after these things."

Revelation 15:1 TLB

And I saw in heaven another mighty pageant **showing** things to come: Seven angels were assigned to carry down to earth the seven last plagues-and then at last God's anger will be finished.

Revelation 17:1 AMP

Then one of the seven angels who had the seven bowls came and spoke with me, saying, "Come here, I will **show** you the judgment and doom of the great prostitute who is seated on many waters [influencing nations],

Revelation 19:10 TLB

Then I fell down at his feet to worship him, but he said, "No! Don't! For I am a servant of God just as you are, and as your brother Christians are, who testify of their faith in Jesus. Worship God. The purpose of all prophecy and of all I have **shown** you is to tell about Jesus."

Revelation 21:9 AMP

Then one of the seven angels who had the seven bowls filled with the seven final plagues came and spoke with me, saying, "Come here, I will **show** you the bride, the wife of the Lamb."

Revelation 21:10 AMP

And he carried me away in the Spirit to a vast and lofty mountain, and **showed** me the holy (sanctified) city of Jerusalem coming down out of heaven from God,

Revelation 22:1 AMP

Then the angel **showed** me a river of the water of life, clear as crystal, flowing from the throne of God and of the Lamb (Christ),

Revelation 22:6 AMP

Then he said to me, "These words are faithful and true." And the Lord, the God of the spirits of the prophets, has sent His angel [as a representative] to **show** His bond-servants the things that must soon take place.

Revelation 22:8 AMP

I, John, am the one who heard and saw these things. And when I heard and saw them, I fell down to worship before the feet of the angel who **showed** me these things.
