All Ladies are invited to the Ladies Retreat in February. There are flyers in the foyer with registration instructions, or see Angie Beckett.






There is a sign-up sheet for LTC coaches in the foyer. If you are willing to coach, please sign-up. Roles will be dispersed, coaching wise later.
