Matthew 13: 1-3, 36, 44-46(NIV)

That same day Jesus went out of the house and sat by the lake. ² Such large crowds gathered around him that he got into a boat and sat in it, while all the people stood on the shore. ³ Then he told them many things in parables. . .

³⁶ Then he left the crowd and went into the house. His disciples came to him and said, "Explain to us the parable of the weeds in the field."

⁴⁴The kingdom of heaven is like treasure hidden in a field. When a man found it, he hid it again, and then in his joy went and sold all he had and bought that field.

⁴⁵ "Again, the kingdom of heaven is like a merchant looking for fine pearls. ⁴⁶ When he found one of great value, he went away and sold everything he had and bought it."

Notes:

Two reasons most commentaries have got it wrong (I humbly suggest)

- Romans 6:23 "but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord."
 Romans 3:11 "There is none that seeketh after God."
- ii. Matthew 13:37-38 "He answered, 'The one who sowed the good seed is the Son of Man.

 38 The field is the world."

	2 Corinthians 8:9 - "though he was rich, <u>yet for your sake he became poor</u> , so that you <u>through his poverty might become rich.</u> "
4.	What is the meaning of the man's joy?
	Hebrews 12:2 - "For the joy set before Him He endured the cross." Luke 15:10 - "rejoicing in the presence of the angels over one sinner that repents."
5.	Is there a spiritual meaning to "he hid it again"?
