Who is God?

6 For to us a child is born, to us a son is given, and the government will be on his shoulders. And he will be called Wonderful Counsellor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. (Isaiah 9:6)

1. God is mighty because of His strength.

28 Do you not know? Have you not heard? The Lord is the everlasting God, the Creator of the ends of the earth. He will not grow tired or weary, and his understanding no one can fathom. 29 He gives strength to the weary and increases the power of the weak. 30 Even youths grow tired and weary, and young men stumble and fall; 31 but those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint. (Isaiah 40:28-31)

2. God is mighty in His acts.

3. God is mighty in Human Form.

*6 Who, being in very nature^a God,
did not consider equality with God something to be used to his own advantage;
7 rather, he made himself nothing
by taking the very nature^b of a servant,
being made in human likeness.
8 And being found in appearance as a man,
he humbled himself
by becoming obedient to death—
even death on a cross!
9 Therefore God exalted him to the highest place
and gave him the name that is above every name,
10 that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow,
in heaven and on earth and under the earth,
11 and every tongue acknowledge that Jesus Christ is Lord,
to the glory of God the Father. (Philippians 2:6-11)*

How does the Mighty God work in our lives today?

4. Jesus is mighty to save!

*Who is this coming from Edom, from Bozrah, with his garments stained crimson? Who is this, robed in splendor, striding forward in the greatness of his strength? “It is I, proclaiming victory, **mighty to save.**” (Isaiah 63:1)*

*14 They will wage war against the Lamb, but **the Lamb will triumph over them** because he is Lord of lords and King of kings—and with him will be his called, chosen and faithful followers.” (Revelation 17:14)*
