




Donations are always welcomed. Please place items on the table in the hallway near the fellowship hall.

Here are some suggestions but feel free to bring anything you think people might need or would appreciate.



- Canned protein items such as fish or chicken
- Soup packets or cans
- Fruit (dried, canned or small cups)
- Vegetables
- Snack items (granola bars, fruit bars, protein bars)
- Drinks (juice boxes, bottled water, powdered mixes)
- Dried potato mixes
- Pasta and pasta mixes including those with protein
- Small packets of pancake mix, syrup
