PASTOR'S WELCOME

Dear Church Family,

As we begin a new year together, I want to take a moment to reflect on an important question: *Why are we willing to grow?*

Growth is not always easy. It can feel uncomfortable, uncertain, and sometimes even risky... especially in the church, where so much of what we do is deeply meaningful and rooted in memory and tradition. Growth can raise questions and stir emotions, and that is both normal and faithful. The church has always lived in the tension between honoring what has shaped us and responding to where God is leading us next.

Our willingness to grow is not about chasing trends or changing for the sake of change. It is about faithfulness. Throughout Scripture, God's people are called to listen, to discern, and to move when the Spirit leads. This will sometimes be into unfamiliar places. Jesus himself often invited people to leave what was comfortable in order to step into deeper trust, deeper love, and deeper discipleship.

We are willing to grow because our calling remains the same: to love God, love our neighbors, and bear witness to Christ in the world. Growth allows us to speak that same gospel in ways that can be heard, felt, and lived by those around us today. We are also willing to grow because the church does not exist for itself alone. We are here for the sake of the world God loves; our neighbors, our community, and future generations. Growth is one way we practice hospitality, making room for others to encounter grace, belonging, and hope.

As we move into this year, I ask for your prayers, your patience, and your openness. Some new efforts we embark on for growth will work well; others may not. That is part of faithful growth. What matters most is that we walk forward together, grounded in grace and guided by the Spirit.

May this year be one in which we listen deeply, love generously, and trust that God—who has been faithful in the past—is still at work among us now.



Introducing L.I.F.T. – Ladies in Faith & Fellowship Together

Our first study, Bad Girls of the Bible by Liz Curtis Higgs, set the foundation as we completed weekly assignments, watched her video teachings, and began forming the special bonds that define our group today. Over the past four years, we have:
