We look forward to seeing you there.

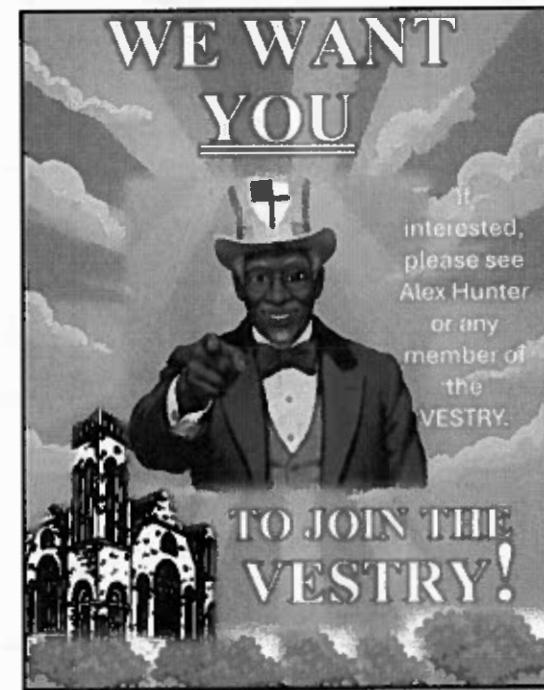
To All Ministry Leaders and Committee Chairs:
