## Church Building Bathroom Renovation Update

The church building bathrooms were classrooms that were made into restrooms in 1973. It's time for an update!

The goal is to update the bathrooms for aesthetics, handicap accessibility when possible, and to turn both rooms into "family restrooms". It will be quite the undertaking. We have a small group of dedicated church members willing to tackle the organization of this project. We have room for additional members, if you have an interest in joining us.

The first step was to update the electrical box that was in the men's bathroom. The cost for this upgrade was approximately \$2,800. We were pleased to receive the funds and we completed this step. The next step will involve a host of other activities including:

- Removal of the divider stalls.
- Plumbing to make each room have one toilet.
- New flooring.
- New vanities.
- Painting of rooms including the ceiling.
- Sheetrock for the walls and possibly ceiling.
- New lighting, mirrors, paper towel dispensers, door locks, handicap rails and other miscellaneous items.

It is necessary to obtain funding for this undertaking. We have been blessed with the donations that have come in, both from individuals and from the pancake feed/silent auction. The Bathroom Reno Team is exploring options and welcomes ideas about the progress of the project with both funding and upgrades. Donations are always welcome! We will make every effort to keep you posted on our progress.
