Below is a concise overview of the vision and direction shared during our recent KDMI Vision Meeting. These points reflect our heart, priorities, and next steps as we move forward together in unity.

- 2026 Theme: The Year of Establishment – focusing on strong foundations, clear systems, healthy growth, and long-term sustainability.
- Leadership & Education: Launch of the Valor Christian College Cohort, offering accredited degrees with up to 40% tuition discounts for KDMI members.
- Service Schedule: Sunday Worship at 1:00 PM (In-Person 1st & 3rd Sundays at 378 Auburn Ave, Virtual 2nd, 4th & 5th Sundays). Tuesday Night Virtual Bible Study at 7:00 PM.
- Men's Fellowship: Planning the introduction of Man Cave Mondays, focused on faith, brotherhood, and Kingdom business principles.
- Community Outreach: Quarterly serve days beginning in Pontiac, starting with partnership efforts through Forgotten Harvest.
- Evangelism & Growth: Each member encouraged to invite one person monthly and help them connect through our website and app.
- Ministerial Direction: KDMI is now operating under Legacy Dominion Fellowship International while maintaining alignment with Valor Christian College and City Harvest.
- Care & Covering: Continued commitment to prayer, support, and care for members facing spiritual, emotional, or financial challenges.
- Looking Ahead: Exploring a July fellowship reset month and continued connection through Dominion Camp Meeting in Columbus, Ohio.
