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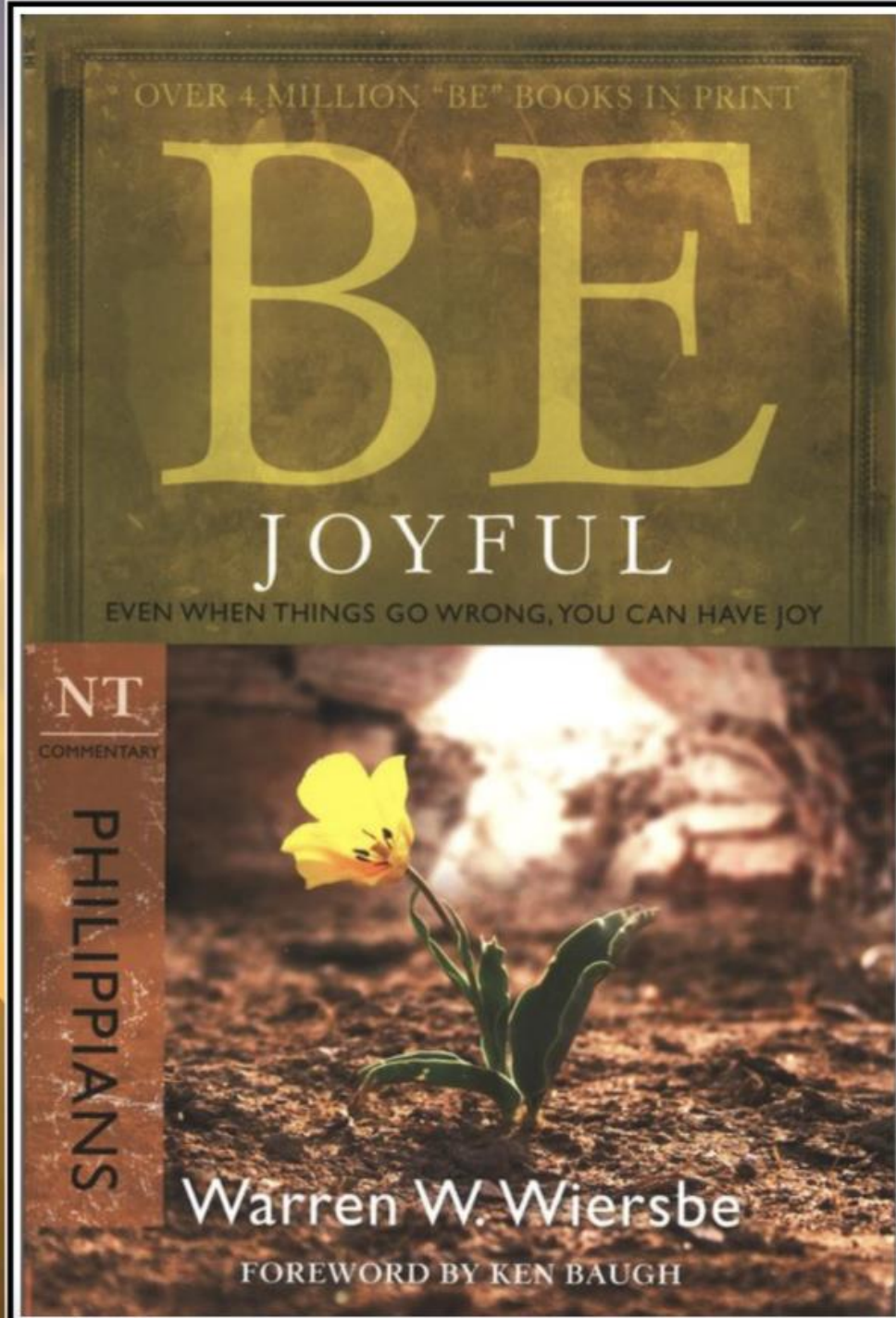

INCREASING YOUR JOY



1 Thessalonians 5:16

“Be joyful always.”

2 Corinthians 11:23-27

“I’ve worked much harder, been jailed more often, beaten up more times than I can count, and at death’s door time after time. I’ve been flogged five times with the Jews’ thirty-nine lashes, beaten by Roman rods three times, pummeled with rocks once.

2 Corinthians 11:23-27

I've been shipwrecked three times, and immersed in the open sea for a night and a day. In hard traveling year in and year out, I've had to ford rivers, fend off robbers, struggle with friends, struggle with foes.

2 Corinthians 11:23-27

I've been at risk in the city, at risk in the country, endangered by desert sun and sea storm, and betrayed by those I thought were my brothers. I've known drudgery and hard labor, many a long and lonely night without sleep, many a missed meal, blasted by the cold, naked to the weather."

2 Corinthians 12:7

*“...because of these surpassingly great revelations. Therefore, in order to keep me from becoming conceited, I was given **a thorn in my flesh**, a messenger of Satan, to torment me.”*

Paul's source of joy:

- *“In the Lord.”* (3:1; 4:4; 4:10)
- Paul placed his **confidence** and **hope** in the **character** and **nature of God** instead of his difficulties, pain or constant change of circumstances.

Paul's source of joy:

1. His confidence in the sovereignty of God
2. His hope in heaven

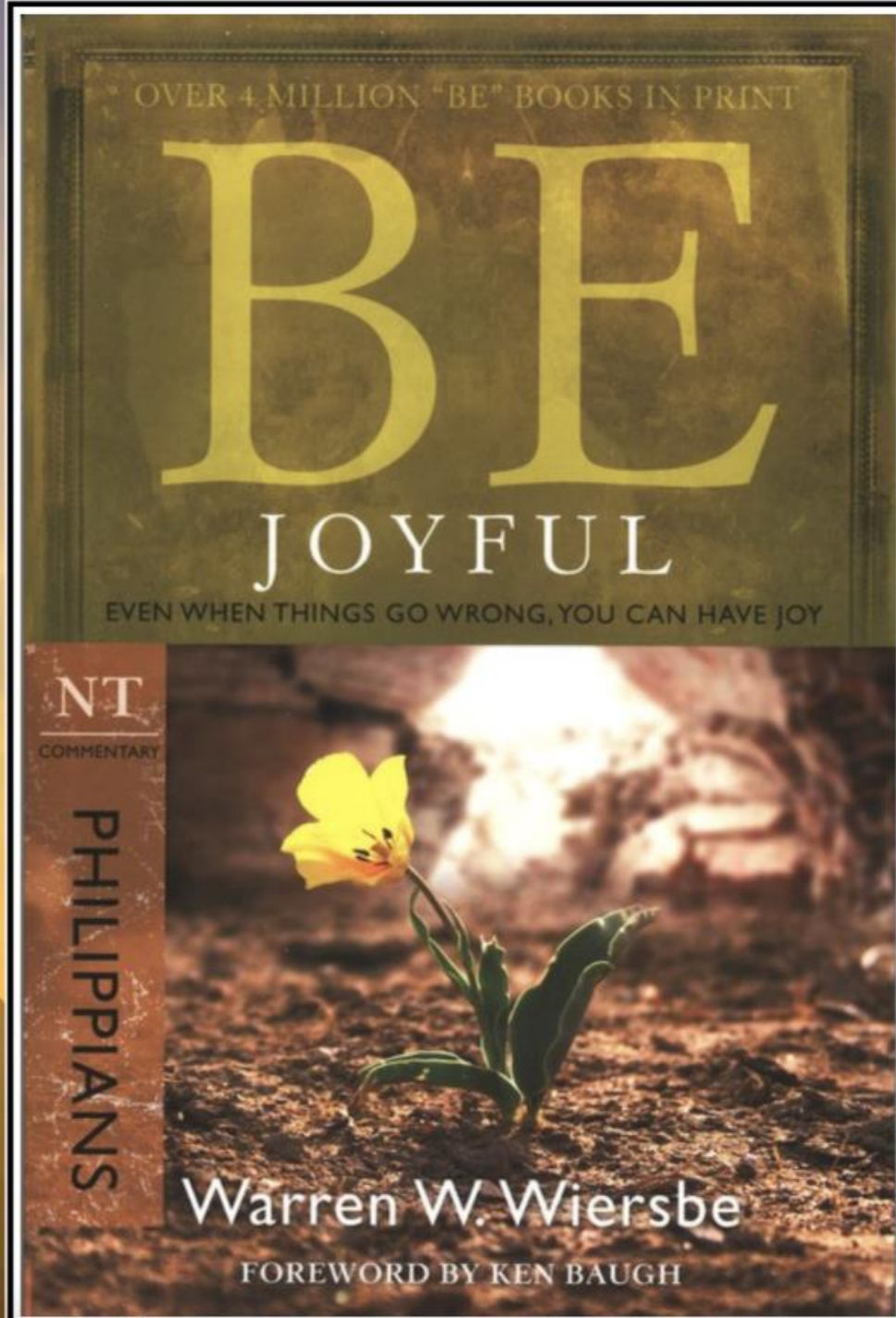

Phillipians 1:11-11

- *¹Paul and Timothy, servants of Christ Jesus,
To all God's holy people in Christ Jesus at
Philippi, together with the overseers and
deacons: ² Grace and peace to you from God
our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. ³ I
thank my God every time I remember
you. ⁴ In all my prayers for all of you, I
always pray with joy*

Phillipians 1:11-11

- *⁵ because of your partnership in the gospel from the first day until now, ⁶ being confident of this, that he who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus. ⁷ It is right for me to feel this way about all of you, since I have you in my heart and,*

Phillipians 1:11-11

- *whether I am in chains or defending and confirming the gospel, all of you share in God's grace with me. ⁸ God can testify how I long for all of you with the affection of Christ Jesus. ⁹ And this is my prayer: that your love may abound more and more in knowledge and depth of insight,*

Phillipians 1:11-11

- ¹⁰ *so that you may be able to discern what is best and may be pure and blameless for the day of Christ, ¹¹ filled with the fruit of righteousness that comes through Jesus Christ—to the glory and praise of God.*

John 15:11

*“These things have I spoken unto you, that **my joy** might remain in you, and that **your joy** might be full.”*

Joy-Stealers:

1. Circumstances
2. People
3. Things
4. Worry

Paul's single mind:

1. He lived for Christ and the gospel.
2. He lived to glorify the Lord.
3. He lived to share the gospel with others.

Paul's single mind:

1. I have you in my **mind** (V.3-6)
2. I have you in my **heart** (V.7-8)
3. I have you in my **prayers** (V.9-11)

Phillipians 1:3-6 – I have you in my mind

- ³ *I thank my God every time I remember you.⁴ In all my prayers for all of you, I always pray with joy⁵ because of your partnership in the gospel from the first day until now,⁶ being confident of this, that he who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus.*

God's three-fold work in our lives:

1. The work God does for us - Salvation
2. The work God does in us - Sanctification
3. The work God does through us - Service

1 John 3:2

“We shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is.”

Phillipians 1:7-8 – I have you in my heart

- ⁷ *It is right for me to feel this way about all of you, since I have you in my heart and, whether I am in chains or defending and confirming the gospel, all of you share in God's grace with me. ⁸ God can testify how I long for all of you with the affection of Christ Jesus.*

1 John 3:14

“We know that we have passed from death unto life, because we love the brethren.”

Romans 5:5

“God has poured out his love into our hearts by the Holy spirit, whom he has given us.”

1 Peter 4:8

“Above all, love each other deeply, because love cover over a multitude of sins.”

Phillipians 1:9-11 – I have you in my prayers

- ⁹ *And this is my prayer: that **your love** may abound more and more in **knowledge and depth of insight**, ¹⁰ so that you may be able to **discern what is best** and **may be pure and blameless** for the day of Christ, ¹¹ filled with the **fruit of righteousness** that comes through Jesus Christ—to the **glory and praise of God**.*

Paul's Prayer:

1. A prayer for maturity in Love
2. A prayer for maturity in Character
3. A prayer for maturity in Service

Conclusion:

This is true Christian fellowship, a "having-in-common" that is much deeper than mere **friendship**. I have you in my mind, in my heart and in my prayers. This is the kind of **fellowship** that produces **joy**, and it is the single mind that produces this kind of **fellowship**.

Conclusion:

A fellowship with the gospel is a fellowship with the truth, with Jesus, and one another and that increases our joy.

And that is really "*Good News*" for us today!
