- Oversee all aspects of the Sunday morning gathering and ensure it's done with excellence
- Build team leaders and teams to run a healthy ministry
- Provide care and support for worship team members both musically and spiritually
- Recruit, train and develop new worship team members
- Develop effective systems and structures to support ministry operations
- Oversee Sunday gathering teams and storytelling
- Plan, organize and coordinate special seasonal church events (i.e. Christmas Eve, Worship Nights, All Ages Services, etc.)
- Manage and administer ministry budget
- Update worship ministry equipment or infrastructure as needed
- Attend all staff meetings and trainings
- Help oversee church assimilation and connection
