Matthew 5:44 AMP

But I say to you, love [that is, unselfishly seek the best or higher good for] your enemies and **pray** for those who persecute you,

Matthew 6:5 AMP

"Also, when you **pray**, do not be like the hypocrites; for they love to **pray** [publicly] standing in the synagogues and on the corners of the streets so that they may be seen by men. I assure you and most solemnly say to you, they [already] have their reward in full.

Matthew 6:6 AMP

But when you **pray**, go into your most private room, close the door and **pray** to your Father who is in secret, and your Father who sees [what is done] in secret will reward you.

Matthew 6:7 AMP

"And when you **pray**, do not use meaningless repetition as the Gentiles do, for they think they will be heard because of their many words.

Matthew 6:8 AMP

So do not be like them [**praying** as they do]; for your Father knows what you need before you ask Him.

Matthew 6:9 AMP

"**Pray**, then, in this way: 'Our Father, who is in heaven, Hallowed be Your name.

Matthew 9:38 AMP

So **pray** to the Lord of the harvest to send out workers into His harvest."

Matthew 11:25 TLB

And Jesus **prayed** this **prayer**: "O Father, Lord of heaven and earth, thank you for hiding the truth from those who think themselves so wise, and for revealing it to little children.

Matthew 14:23 AMP

After He had dismissed the crowds, He went up on the mountain by Himself to **pray**. When it was evening, He was there alone.

Matthew 17:21 AMP

[But this kind of demon does not go out except by **prayer** and fasting.]"

Matthew 18:19 HCSB

Again, I assure you: If two of you on earth agree about any matter that you **pray** for, it will be done for you by My Father in heaven.

Matthew 19:13 AMP

Then children were brought to Jesus so that He might place His hands on them [for a blessing] and **pray**; but the disciples reprimanded them.

Matthew 21:13 AMP

Jesus said to them, "It is written [in Scripture], 'MY HOUSE SHALL BE CALLED A HOUSE OF **PRAYER**'; but you are making it a ROBBERS' DEN."

Matthew 21:22 AMP

And whatever you ask for in **prayer**, believing, you will receive."

Matthew 23:5 TLB

"Everything they do is done for show. They act holy by wearing on their arms little **prayer** boxes with Scripture verses inside, and by lengthening the memorial fringes of their robes.

Matthew 23:13 TLB

"Woe to you, Pharisees, and you other religious leaders. Hypocrites! For you won't let others enter the Kingdom of Heaven and won't go in yourselves. And you pretend to be holy, with all your long, public **prayers** in the streets, while you are evicting widows from their homes. Hypocrites!

Matthew 23:14 AMP

[Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites, because you swallow up widows' houses, and to cover it up you make long **prayers**; therefore you will receive the greater condemnation.]

Matthew 24:20 AMP

**Pray** that your flight [from persecution and suffering] will not be in winter, or on a Sabbath [when Jewish laws prohibit travel].

Matthew 26:36 AMP

Then Jesus came with them to a place called Gethsemane (olive-press), and He told His disciples, "Sit here while I go over there and **pray**."

Matthew 26:39 AMP

And after going a little farther, He fell face down and **prayed**, saying, "My Father, if it is possible [that is, consistent with Your will], let this cup pass from Me; yet not as I will, but as You will."

Matthew 26:41 AMP

Keep actively watching and **praying** that you may not come into temptation; the spirit is willing, but the body is weak."

Matthew 26:42 AMP

He went away a second time and **prayed**, saying, "My Father, if this cannot pass away unless I drink it, Your will be done."

Matthew 26:44 AMP

So, leaving them again, He went away and **prayed** for the third time, saying the same words once more.

Matthew 26:53 KJVS

Thinkest thou that I cannot now **pray** to my Father, and he shall presently give me more than twelve legions of angels?
