Series Orientation

Series Big Idea: We, the Church, remain as a continuation of the book of Acts. The work that Jesus finished on the cross he now continues through his Spirit-filled church.

Acts Anchor Question

What is Jesus continuing to do—how are we invited to participate?

Acts is not just information to learn, but a story we are intentionally called into.

1. What Jesus Began (1-3)

What does this text reveal about Jesus' mission, authority, and promises?

- Key words / phrases that stand out:
- What does this tell us about Jesus today, not just then?

2. What the Spirit is Doing (4-5)

Where is God acting, moving, empowering, disrupting, or directing?

- How does the Spirit show up in this passage?
- What changes because the Spirit is present?
- What assumptions or expectations are challenged?

3. What the Church is Becoming (6-8)

How is God forming or transforming his people?

- How does the Spirit show up in this passage?
- What changes because the Spirit is present?
- What assumptions or expectations are challenged?

4. Where this text Meets My Life (9-11...)

How does this text enter into and inform my current life context?

- Where does this text intersect with my current season?
- What question does this passage ask me?
- Where might Jesus be inviting trust, obedience, or courage?

5. What fears, expectations, or distractions does this text gently expose?
6. How does this passage invite deeper trust in Jesus and dependence on the Spirit?

Looking Around – Community & Witness

7. How does this text shape the way we relate to one another as a church?
8. What would it look like to live this passage out together, not just individually?
9. Where might God be positioning us for witness—near or far?

Looking Forward – Participation in God's Ongoing Work

10. What step of obedience or attentiveness feels most pressing this week?
11. Where might Jesus be asking us to wait, pray, speak, or move?
12. Who in our lives might God be drawing toward Himself through us?
