Dear Friends in Christ,

What does Easter mean to you? When we were young Easter was a time of Egg hunts, Easter breakfast, Easter baskets and of course the Easter Bunny. For me Easter was many times the celebration of a birthday, after all I was born on Easter Sunday 1963. I have fond memories of the sugar eggs my mom would make for me when my birthday landed on easter. The outside of the egg was decorated with icing and the inside was a scene. One time my mother displayed the empty tomb of Our Savior Jesus.

Now that was and is Easter, the empty tomb. The tomb was sealed with a large boulder at the entrance. If you go to Israel there are many tombs throughout the country. One area we visited there were smaller tombs only about 5-6 feet high. The stone that was beside the entrance was smaller but still must have weighed similar to a small car. But Jesus was not buried in a small tomb he was buried in a rich man's tomb.

Matthew 27:57 As evening approached, there came a rich man from Arimathea, named Joseph, who had himself become a disciple of Jesus. 58 Going to Pilate, he asked for Jesus' body, and Pilate ordered that it be given to him. 59 Joseph took the body, wrapped it in a clean linen cloth, 60 and placed it in his own new tomb that he had cut out of the rock. He rolled a big stone in front of the entrance to the tomb and went away.

Matthew 27:64 So give the order for the tomb to be made secure until the third day. Otherwise, his disciples may come and steal the body and tell the people that he has been raised from the dead. This last deception will be worse than the first."

Between the size of the boulder and the fact it was sealed should be proof enough, but the Romans went further and put a guard. But today many do not believe and are skeptics. Some just doubt and some even doubt about the grace God has given us in Christ. Take another at Matthew 27:64 then 27:62 and 63 **The next day, the one after Preparation Day, the chief priests and the Pharisees went to Pilate. 63 "Sir," they said, "we remember that while he was still alive that deceiver said, 'After three days I will rise again.'**

John 5:24 "Very truly I tell you, whoever hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal life and will not be judged but has crossed over from death to life. It is not what we know but what we believe. Faith in Jesus is what He has given us through His Word. We will not be judged by God. This is what we have right now. So, believe, believe that God sent His Son Jesus to take your sins to the cross and after three days rose again defeating death for you.
