2026 is a year of concentration, clarity, and spiritual alignment.

This is a season where clarity is not accidental it is cultivated. As our eyes become fixed and our hearts become undivided, the fog lifts and direction becomes unmistakable. The Lord is sharpening discernment so that His people are no longer led by impulse, emotion, or urgency, but by truth and conviction.
