Staying Close to Jesus

1. _____ - Psalm 122:1

- David was in community, not in isolation - notice the plural pronouns:
"I was glad when THEY said unto me, Let US go to the house of the Lord."
- Glad—to brighten, cheer up; a celebration, holiday (Exodus 4:14; 1 Samuel 11:9; Esther 8:15-17).

2. **Daily Personal _____ with God**

- Carving out daily, deliberate time free from distractions is key to staying close to God (Matthew 6:6,11).
- Include worship, prayer, getting into the Bible, and listening to God's Word and the Spirit's voice.

3. _____ **in the presence of Jesus**

"I am the vine, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing." - John 15:5

- Like a branch connected to a vine—we draw life, strength, and nourishment from Christ to bear spiritual fruit: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control.
- It's a life-long journey of learning to abide.
