
Adult Faith Formation - January 25

2026 Synod Assembly

Each year at the annual meeting, we elect at least two (2) lay members of the congregation to be voting members at the year's Synod Assembly. In order to be elected, you must be a voting member of Prince of Peace. We are also allowed to elect one (1) additional voting member who is a youth or young adult who is confirmed and under the age of 25. The assembly is something like our congregational annual meeting for the ministry of the North/West Lower Michigan Synod, of which we are a member congregation. Voting members receive reports from synod committees and officers and the Bishop, review and approve the synod budget and compensation guidelines, and more. There are also excellent educational workshops and powerful worship services! This year we are honored to be hosting the assembly at Prince of Peace, so attending will be as close to home as it gets!
