

# **Am I My Brother's Keeper?**

## **Week 1: Who is My Brother?**

### **The Bible is full of brothers.**

Very often when the word brother appears in the Bible it is the Greek word *adelphos*. It literally means “*of the same womb*”.

- It can indicate actual siblings. (*Mark 6:3*)
- There are cases where it indicates close family members, (*Genesis 14:14*)
- It also is used to explain the close connections of believers in Christ. (*Matthew 12:46-50*)
- This family language also indicates how we should treat each other. (*1 John 3:11-16*)

**We have a responsibility to each other.**  
**This is a condition we call ACCOUNTABILITY.**

***It all started with the first brothers.* (*Genesis 4*)**

1. **Birth always brings HOPE for the future.** (*Genesis 3:15*).
2. **The problem with Cain's offering was his HEART.**  
(*Hebrews 11:4; 1 John 3:12*)
3. **God INTERVENES.**

**Our culture elevates INDEPENDENCE as a virtue.**  
***Where do we stray when we live that way?***

***What led to Cain's fate? Unwillingness to live an EXAMINED LIFE.***

***We all have two YOUS: The “visible” YOU and the “real” YOU.***

- The visible YOU is the one known by OTHERS.
- **But the real YOU is who you are on the INSIDE.**  
This is the YOU that is known by GOD.

(OVER)

**God does not applaud INDIVIDUALISM;  
He designed us for ACCOUNTABILITY.**

Christian accountability is:

- (1) Christ-oriented
- (2) Reciprocal
- (3) Personal
