




Revive UMC Azle Announcements



Revive donated 2,411 pounds of food and \$5,310.00 to the Community Caring Center in 2025! We are so glad to be able to join hands to feed hungry families in greater Azle. Thank you for your donations and for your missional heart!! Revive is about serving our neighbors. Their current needs are mac 'n cheese, canned tuna, canned soups, instant mashed potatoes, rice, beans, cereal, and ramen.. Every Sunday, we collect food at worship, so bring donations with you. On the first Sunday of the month, you can also bring your plastic bags.
