The Baptism of Jesus

As the people were filled with expectation and all were questioning in their hearts concerning John, whether he might be the Messiah, John answered all of them by saying, "I baptize you with water, but one who is more powerful than I is coming; I am not worthy to untie the strap of his sandals. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire. Steps Toward Holiness

1. Prioritize Prayer

- **What to Do:** Dedicate time daily to prayer. Use the Lord's Prayer or speak from the heart.
- **Why It Matters:** Prayer connects us to God and aligns our hearts with His will.
- *"Without prayer, there is no holiness."*

2. Live the Faith

- **What to Do:** Attend Worship regularly and participate in congregational life.
- **Why It Matters:** Worship realigns us with God's grace, the fuel for the journey toward holiness.
- *"The Eucharist is the source and summit of Christian life."*

3. Embrace Scripture

- **What to Do:** Read a small portion of the Bible daily, meditating on its meaning.
- **Why It Matters:** God's Word is a roadmap for living a holy life.
- *"Ignorance of Scripture is ignorance of Christ." - St. Jerome*

4. Practice Charity

- **What to Do:** Perform acts of kindness and serve those in need.
- **Why It Matters:** Holiness grows through love, and love is made real in service.
- *"What you did for the least of these, you did for me." - Matthew 25:40*

5. Cultivate Virtue

- **What to Do:** Focus on one virtue at a time (e.g., patience, humility).
- **Why It Matters:** Virtues are habits that shape us into Christ-like people.
- *"Holiness means becoming the person God made you to be."*

Inspiration from Peter Kreeft

Kreeft reminds us that holiness is attainable for everyone:

1. **God calls each of us to be saints.** Holiness isn't reserved for a select few but is the purpose of our lives.
2. **It starts with small, daily steps.** Begin where you are, with what you have.
3. **Grace is the key.** We don't achieve holiness on our own but cooperate with God's grace.
