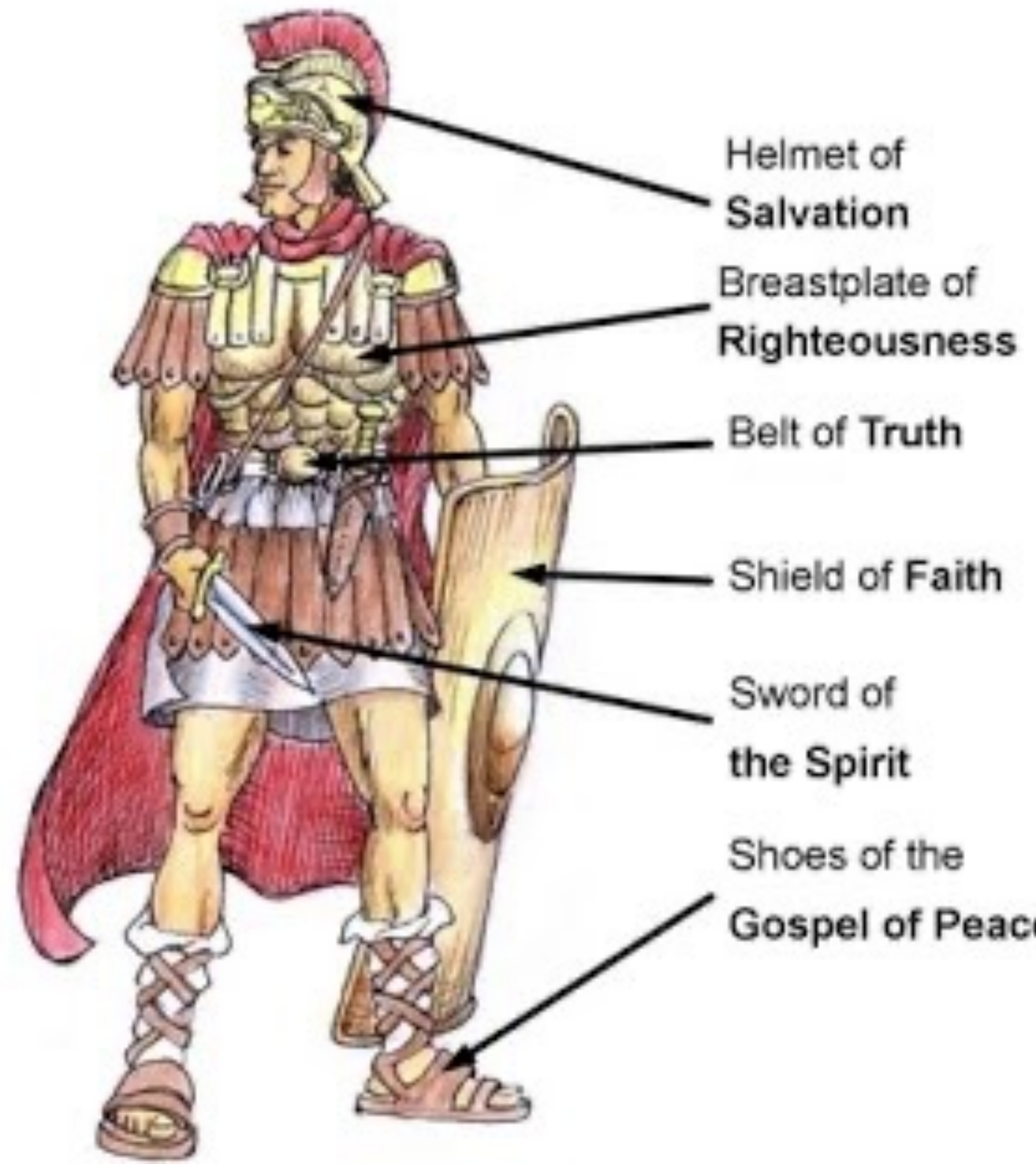

What Is Truth?

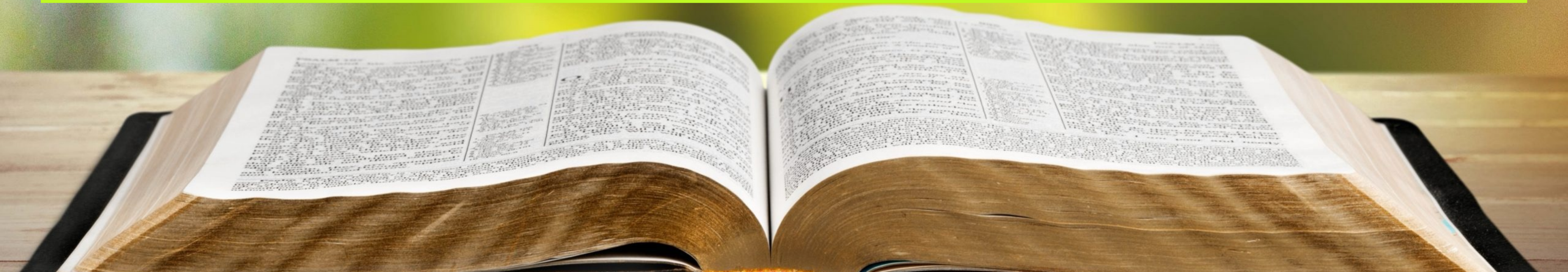
- Find and follow YOUR truth
