Think about devotions as a continuation of our community's worship. The following basic pattern could be one way of forming your household's devotions. Adapt as necessary!

GATHERING

† Light a candle to help you focus this time as "God time."

Prayer of the Week

God of miracles, with your word and power, you changed water into wine. Work in us your miracles of love and faith. Teach us how to share our very best with others as you do with us every day. Amen.

CARING CONVERSATION

Take a moment to check in with each other or to use the questions below.

- ♀ **Highs & Lows:** Name the best thing that happened today. Name the worst thing that happened.
- ♀ **Thinking about This Week's Story:** Jesus was at a wedding. He helped the family when the party ran out of wine by turning plain water into the best wine they had ever tasted. How have you been helpful to someone today? How has someone been helpful to you?
- ♀ **Getting Ready for Next Week's Story:** Jesus becomes angry when some people were misusing the temple. When have you been angry or frustrated today? What was your reason for that?

DAILY BIBLE READING

Read aloud from the DAILY BIBLE READING from the front. What do you want to remember from this reading?

PRAY TOGETHER

† Play a prayer game. Each person says: Dear God, thank you for your miracles, especially for [act out something—an animal, type of flower, special person, etc.]. Amen.


CLOSING

Saturday	Psalm 23:1-6	A Psalm with Overflowing Wine
Sunday	John 2:13-25	Cleansing the Temple
