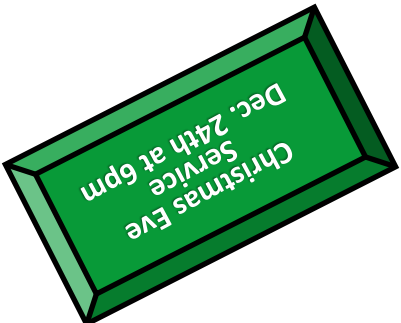

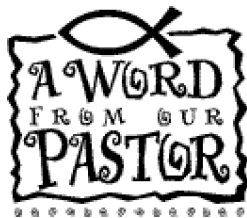

This week I have been cleaning up around the church in preparation for decorating for the celebration of the Christmas season. I have picked up all the propane tanks lying around the church campus. I am in the process of putting away all the construction equipment. I am taking down the hoses and putting away the

extension cords we used for the shower trailer. And I will be rearranging all the outdoor furniture to make it look nice on the porch of the Life Center.

Once I have everything put away, then I will begin to decorate for the celebration of the first coming of Christ. For this Sunday we need the advent wreaths placed in both buildings. Lights need hung. Christmas trees need assembled and decorated. Christmas wreaths need hung. Candles need to be arranged throughout the two worship spaces. And over then next several weeks, I hope to see a multitude of poinsettias brought in to decorate the sanctuary and Life Center buildings.

All this work of cleaning and decorating needs to be done before Christmas Eve and our service to celebrate the arrival of the Messiah on that first Christmas morn.

We have many parables and teachings in the Gospels warning us of the need to be ready, but they all boil down to Jesus' warnings: "

"Therefore keep watch, because you do not know on what day your Lord will come." – **Matthew 24:42** *"Be on guard! Be alert! You do not know when that time will come."* – **Mark 13:33** *"Be always on the watch, and pray that you may be able to escape all that is about to happen, and that you may be able to stand before the Son of Man."* – **Luke 21:36**

What do you need to do to be ready for Christ's second coming. We are told that the day of Christ's return will either be a great and wonderful day or a great and terrible day. And what will make the difference is your point of preparedness. What do you need to clean up before His arrival? What do you need to straight up and rearrange before He arrives? What do you need to add to your life to make it beautiful for the Lord to behold?

The warning is always that his coming will be sudden and will catch many unprepared. Let hat not be us.
