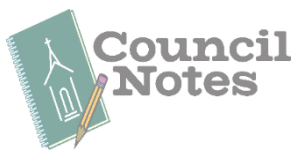

## UPCOMING GATHER BIBLE STUDIES 2026

Winter 2026: “Embodied Prayer” By the Rev. Liv Larson Andrews  
Prayer is an important part of our relationship with God, and one of the ways we respond to God speaking in our lives. At the same time, we may carry all kinds of baggage or heavy questions about prayer: Am I doing it “right?” Do I pray enough? Is prayer always done with words? This two-part Bible study looks to Scripture as a guide to explore some different ways we can pray with our bodies—and with the body of the earth.  
(January) Session One: Praying with our bodies  
Looking to the Apostle Paul, Mary, the Psalms and more, we’ll learn about and try three embodied practices of prayer based on breathing techniques, the use of beads (such as the rosary) and praying in different postures (sitting, standing and kneeling).  
(February) Session Two: Praying with the body of the earth  
Scripture inspires us to regard the natural world as both sacred space and our neighbor. This session explores ways we can pray not only for creation but with creation as our sacred neighbors. As we pray, even the trees and rivers are our prayer partners. The session concludes with the glorious vision in Revelation 22 of a restored world and the river of life.

## NEWS FROM LUTHERAN WORLD RELIEF on BABY CARE KITS

## CANCELLED STAMP MINISTRY:

This is a joint ministry between Peace Lutheran and the Menomonie Alliance Church. How this works: cut or tear off cancelled stamps from your mail, bring them to church and place them in the mailbox by the elevator. Menomonie Alliance folks trim, sort and send them to Shell Point Retirement community in Florida where Residents prepare the stamps to be resold to stamp dealers. The money raised supports preparation and distribution of Spanish language curriculum for Sunday Schools. More than 50 lesson series have been published and are being used in churches in 40 different denominations in 19 different Spanish-speaking countries in South America, Central America and even in the USA.

### Easy Pumpkin Dump Cake- Set oven for 350 degrees

1 15oz can pumpkin puree  
1 12oz can evaporated milk  
3 large eggs or (4 if the eggs are small)  
1 Cup brown sugar  
1 Tablespoon of pie spice  
Mix all the above together.

1 Cup chopped pecans  
1 yellow cake mix  
1 stick of butter

Spray a 9 X 13 pan with pam. Pour mixture in the pan.

Sprinkle one yellow cake mix and over the liquid in the pan and take butter and cut up in slices and spread around the top of the pan. Pour chopped pecans on top and put in the oven to bake for 50 minutes or until a toothpick comes out clean.
