WHO THEY ARE

The Care Team is right at the heart of every DYC weekend – they are folks with great big hearts, out of this world listening skills, keen attention to detail, and are unflappable in stressful or complicated situations.

WHAT THEY DO

The Care Team offers all kinds of care to the participants and leaders at DYC. From first aid and medication distribution to conflict resolution and pastoral support, if someone needs a bit of extra care in any way on the weekend, The Care Team provides it or connects them with the resources or supports who can. They also carefully document accidents, incidents, and medications that have been distributed.

WHAT SPECIAL SKILLS ARE HELPFUL

Individuals are generally invited to be part of the Care Team based on skills or experience that they have. There needs to be at least one person certified in first aid and in mental health first aid, someone with pastoral experience (usually a priest, but not always), and Care Team members are usually experienced youth workers and DYC leaders.

WHAT YOUR WEEKEND WILL LOOK LIKE

Every DYC is different for the Care Team, depending on what comes up during the weekend, but generally Care Team are always at the ready, keeping their hands on the pulse of the weekend, and responding to whatever situations arise.
