WHO THEY ARE

Group Leaders are the day-time superstars of DYC. They've got the best time management skills, can facilitate the daylights out of a conversation, know how to weave fun and connection into every activity, and are flexible to change and adjust to meet the needs of their young people.

WHAT THEY DO

Group Leaders always work alongside at least one other leader and spend their days either with a set group of participants, keep track of who is in their group and where they are at and support their engagement in what we've got going on at DYC. They lead group check-ins and discussions, remind participants of group norms as needed, and respond to the needs of their group, pulling in the Care Team as needed.

WHAT SPECIAL SKILLS ARE HELPFUL

Community and relationship building skills are really the secret sauce for a great group leader. When group leaders help participants make meaningful connections with one another and with God through the weekend's program, that is when DYC is at its fullest potential. Time management, flexibility, and good communication skills are also super helpful!

WHAT YOUR WEEKEND WILL LOOK LIKE

From the start of the program each day, Group Leaders are on deck through to when participants go to their cabins at the end of the day. Group Leaders support and participate alongside young people in their group throughout the day's activities.
