

Jesus said “A new command I give you: “...Love one another. In the same way I loved you, you love one another. This is how everyone will recognize that you are my disciples—when they see the love you have for each other.” John 13 verse 34

If you look at someone and they seem to love really well - they honour by taking action - they give up their own comfort - sacrificing so others can benefit - doing the tough things - often going against the flow - that's a good indication that Jesus is the focus of their lives because as they follow Jesus - they love and honour Him by loving and honouring others! That's our mission as Nashville Road Community Church - to live out the love of God!

To put love into practice, to honour others will always always involve giving of yourself. Jesus said "I am among you as one who serves" (Luke 22 verse 27) and as a church we want to help provide lots of opportunities and the paths to “Give Yourself A-Way” - to live out the love of God by sharing your Availability, your Ability and your Capacity.

Capacity - that's your Treasure, and loving this way is sharing your financial resources to meet practical needs of Nashville Road Community Church as we follow Jesus and live out Gods love.

Greetings from Salerno, Italy.

The work with the leaders is moving forward with them taking on more initiatives and filling in where there are urgent vacant ministry needs. We are encouraging more outreach and visiting. There are some cultural tendencies that lean towards a non-lay person mentality regarding church ministry activities. Leaders normally jump in too quickly instead of patiently delegating ministry. After centuries of empowering a priest to forgive sins through confession, it is culturally a foregone conclusion that he will be expected to perform the majority of the religious functions. This cultural reality can naturally pour over into our churches without the believers even being aware that they have these inclinations,

even if regularly taught the very opposite. This tendency can often also lead to putting energetic people in charge that seek continual admiration, which causes them to take on everything new that is suggested. This obviously cannot end well, as they either burn out, and/or lose their patience. This is par for the course.

Loredana's work continues to help the women have greater awareness with regarding to their worth and dignity before the Lord. It is one of the most promising things we have seen as we see the majority of them not turning back to where they were, even in the face of what it can cost them. They move forward in the Lord with strength, and courage, as they learn to see themselves as the Lord sees them. It is amazing to witness! Many being mothers, and wives, it has also caused a transformation amongst the members within their families, thank God.
