1 Corinthians 10

1. Many of us will sit in a place of blessing not realizing the Journey that it took for us to live a life that is so enriched that has become our default. Do you sit there or are you creating this place. (remember where you came from- or are you entitled)

1 Corinthians 10:1-4/ Exodus 13:21- The Lord went ahead/ **Exodus 14:16**-split the sea/
Exodus 16:15- supernatural food/ **Exodus 17:6**-water from an impossible place

2. There can be moments where God is guiding us to a place of promise, but due to our disobedience we miss out on what the Lord has for us. (all of the people were delivered from Egypt and saw good do many things, but not all saw the promise land)

1 Corinthians 10:5/ Numbers 20:8-12-how much do u trust God-speak not strike(wow)/
Numbers 20:24-Aaron will not enter, he rebelled/ **Numbers 14:29-30**- Drop dead, Caleb Joshua only.

3. Are we quick to learn from the mistakes of our forefathers or will we have to learn the hard way? What evil things are you craving right now and where will it take you?

1 Corinthians 10:6/Proverbs 1:1-4-The purpose of what I've learned, pass it on

4. They died in the wilderness because of their failure of self-discipline and consequent indulgence of every desire, Four major sins characterized them: idolatry (v. 7); sexual immorality (v. 8); testing God (v. 9); and complaining (v. 10).

1 Corinthians 10:7-11/2 Corinthians 10:4-5-line it up against the word/**Numbers 21:4-6**
the bite of testing

5. We are foolish to think we are stronger than people from another time, claiming that was an old time and we know more now. (we are stronger)

1 Corinthians 10:12-13/James 1:13-15-sin grows up and bring death/**Matthew 6:13**-what or who is leading you.

6. There will be some seasons dedicated to wrestling, standing and fighting and you will grow from that, and there will be some season to simply run. Idolatry is the most heinous injury and affront to the true God; it is transferring his worship and honor to a rival.

1 Corinthians 10:14/Psalm 31:1(MSG)-in my running where do I run.

7. The company that we keep will influence us on both side of the coin, to draw closer to Christ or drift away. Who do you unite with and what does it involve.

1 Corinthians 10:15-18/Proverbs 13:20- wise walk/**1 Corinthians 15:33-** who is leading you/**2 Corinthians 6:14-**what load are you carrying and with who

8. When standing for Jesus we must draw the line in the sand and pick a side, Paul reiterates this same thing to the Corinthians.

1 Corinthians 10:19-22/Joshua 24:15- choose on this day

9. When it comes to adhering to the Word, we are often more focus on what we cannot do because it challenges our flesh, God has good intention for you in his word.

1 Corinthians 10:25-30/Jeremiah 29:11- God has plans and they are for us

10. Paul finishes the chapter by tell the Church that whatever they do and whoever is watching make sure God is the priority and his people come to know him.
