September began with a missionary interview in Tennessee that resulted in a new family being approved to plant a church in Boston, Massachusetts. What a joy to see God raising laborers for the spiritually needy Northeast!

The rest of the month found us at the home office handling correspondence, missionary phone calls, and the many details that help keep our missionaries focused on their fields. In late September, we loaded the family into the van and set out on a 6,500-mile western road trip to encourage our church-planting missionaries. We arrived home just in time to catch the final days of our home church's missions conference, where Brother Danny Whetstone, chairman of our board, preached. What a blessing to sit under his ministry! After a quick week at the office catching up, Jeremy and Judah traveled to Pensacola Christian College to represent WWNTBM at their missions conference, speaking with many students and challenging them to give their lives to Christ on the mission field. Arriving home after midnight on the 26th, we turned right around the next morning to head to Ambassador Baptist College for their missions conference through the 31st—another week of pouring into young people and pleading for laborers. God is at work!
